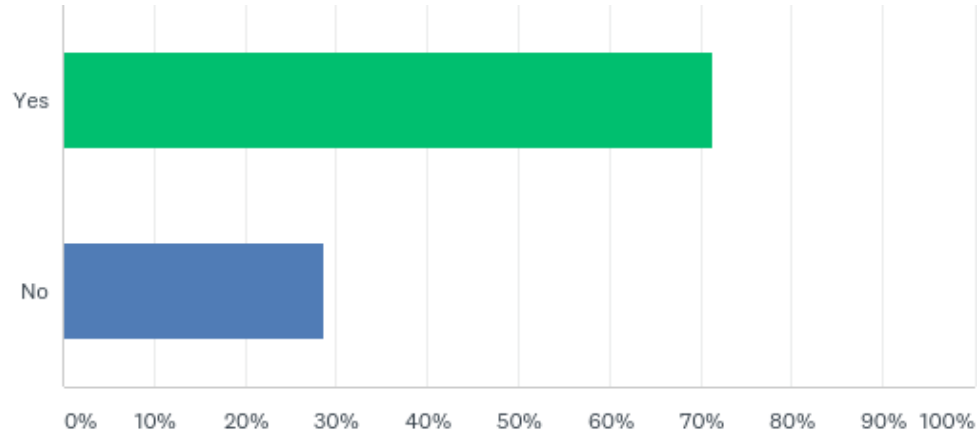

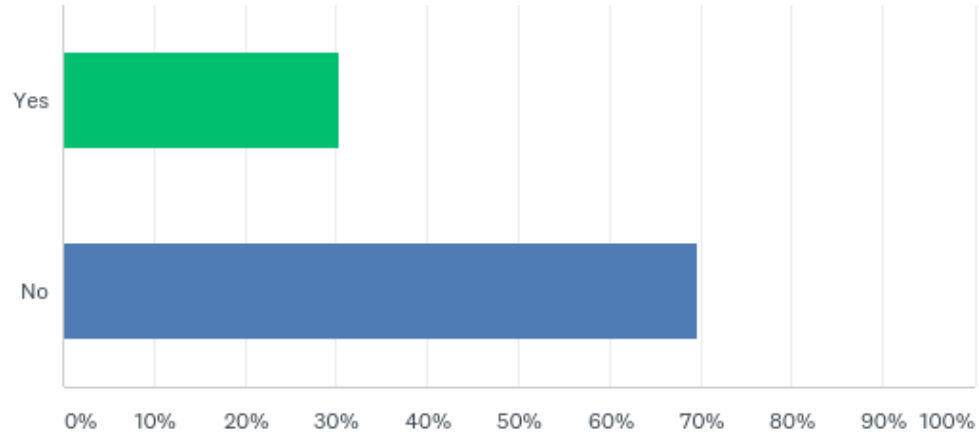

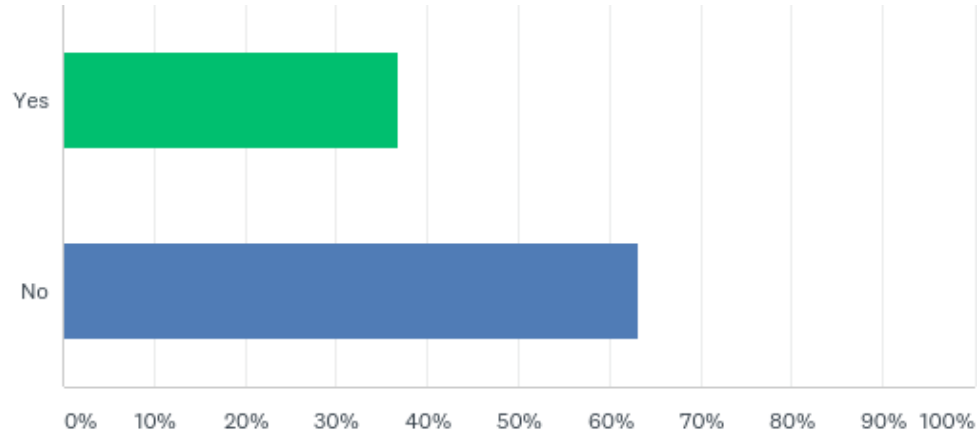

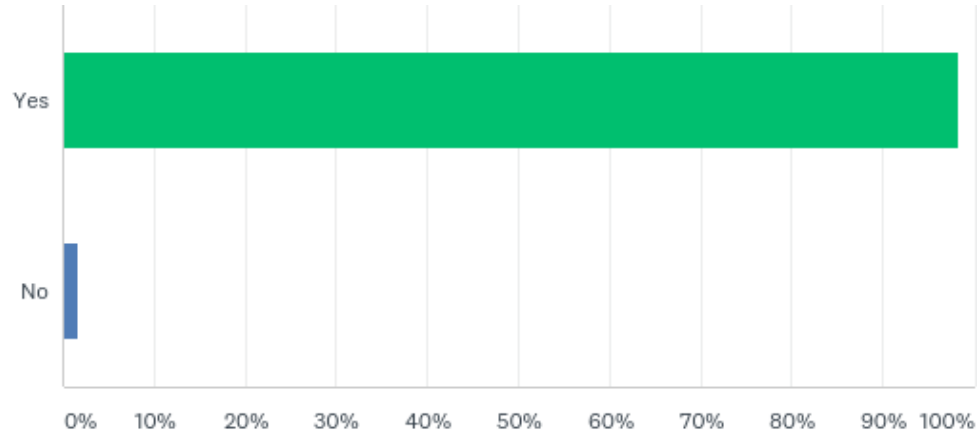

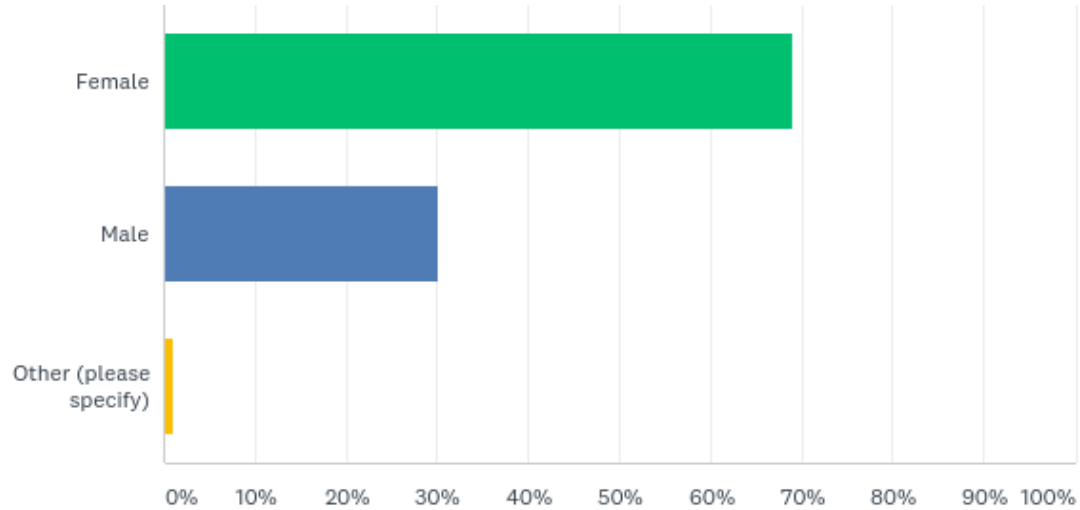

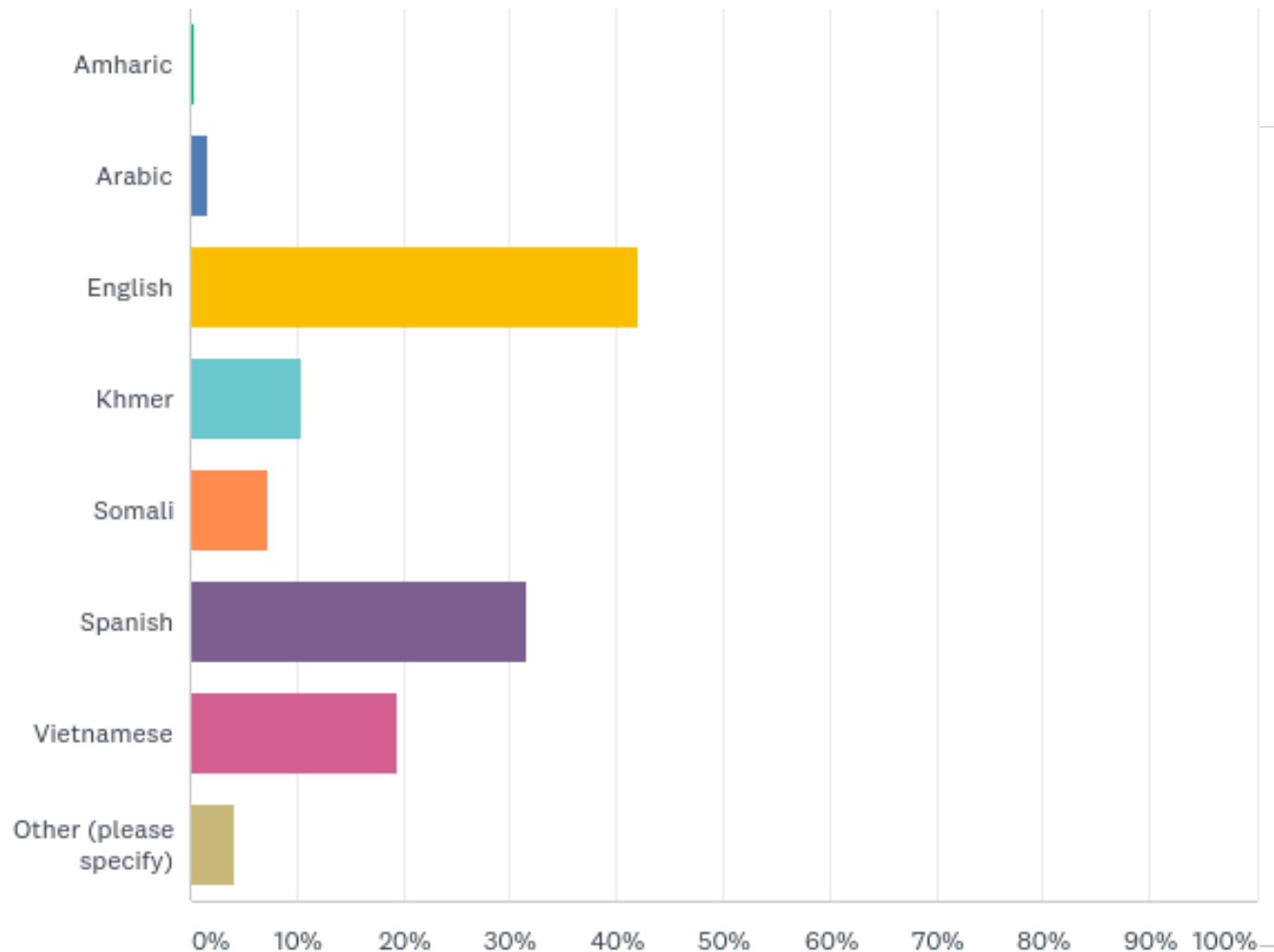

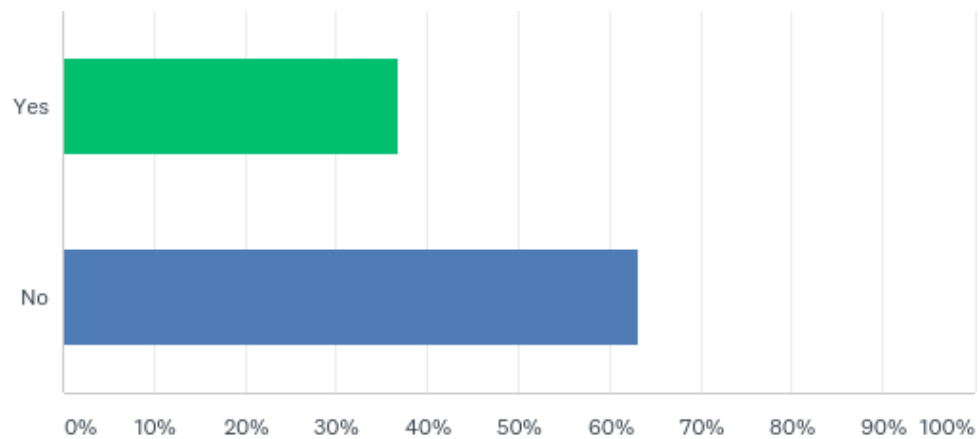

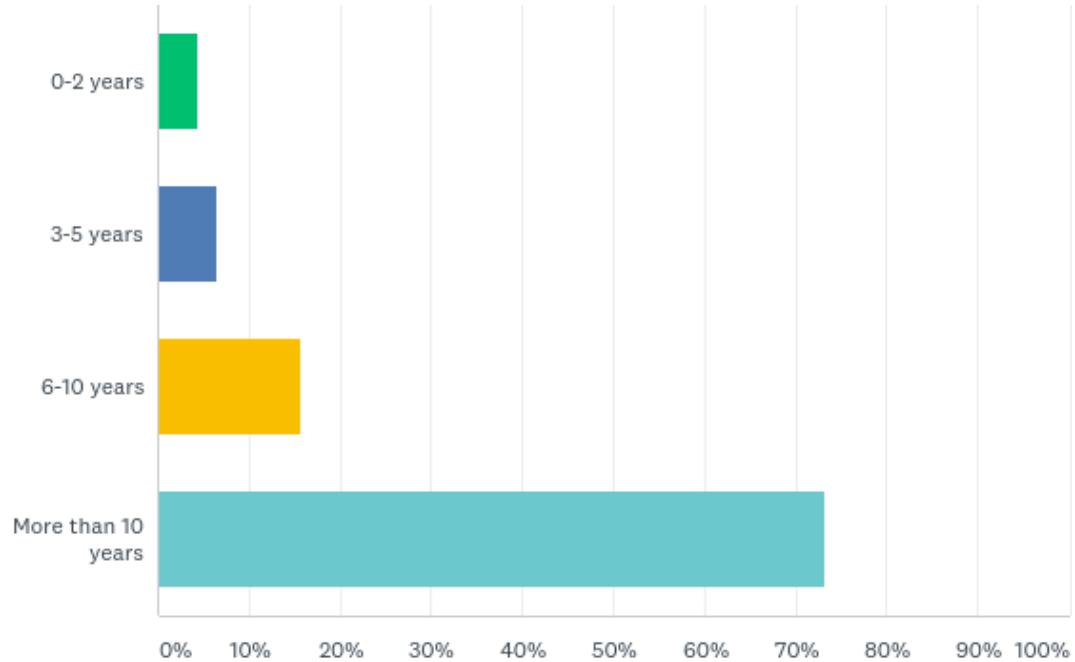

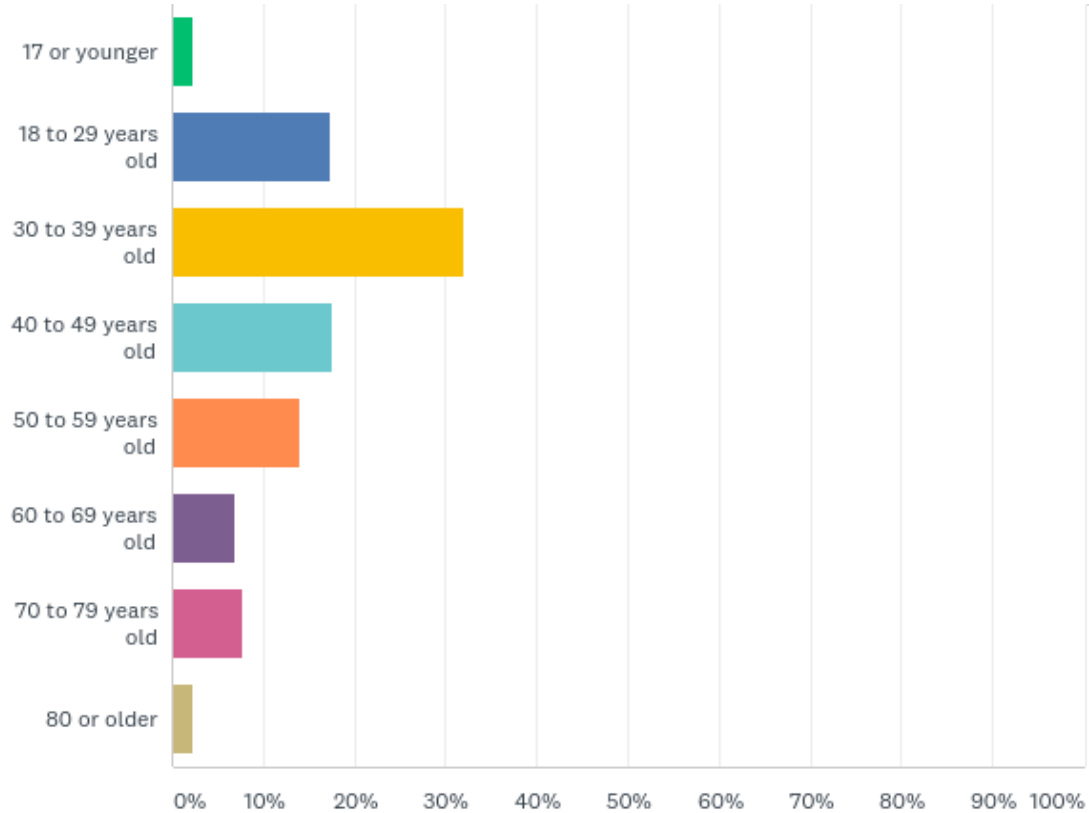

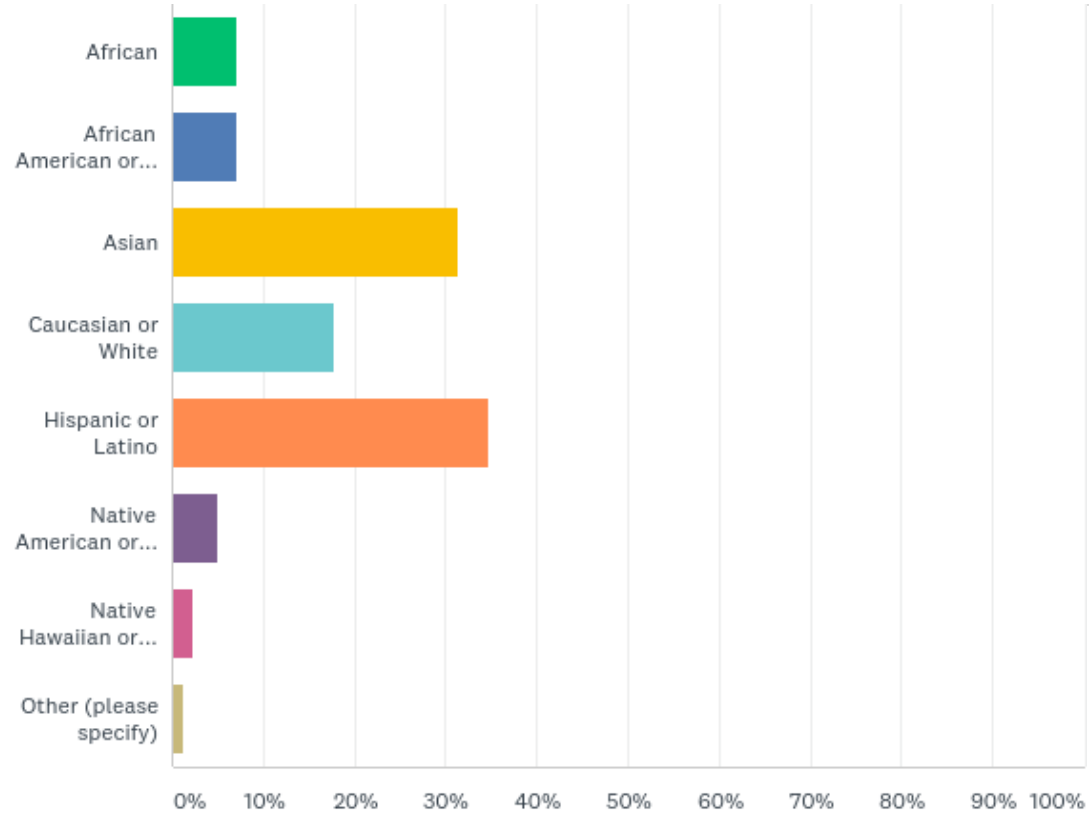

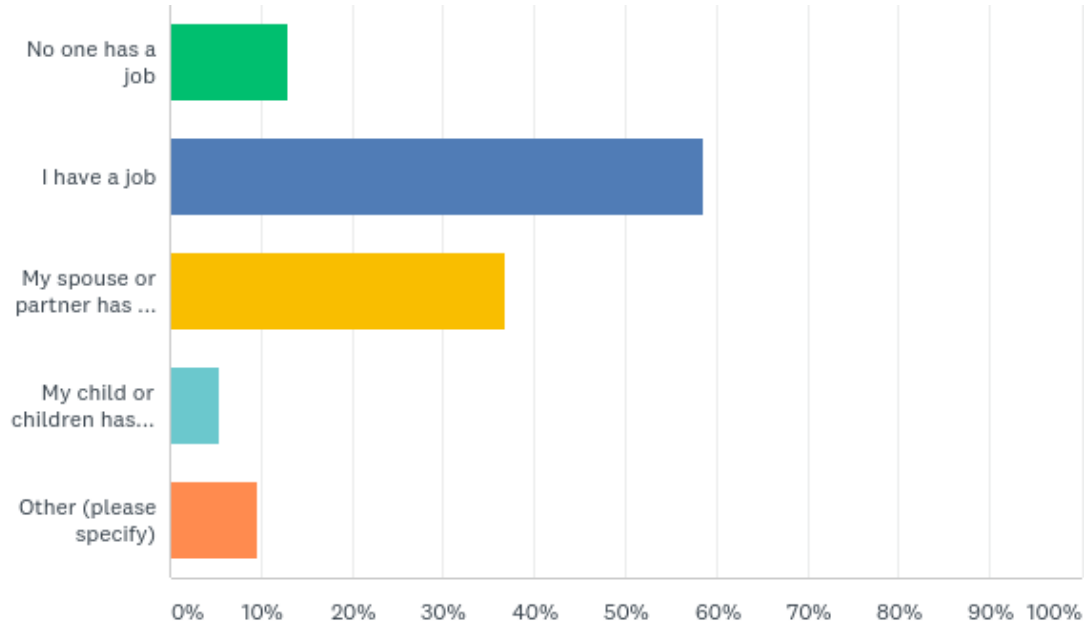

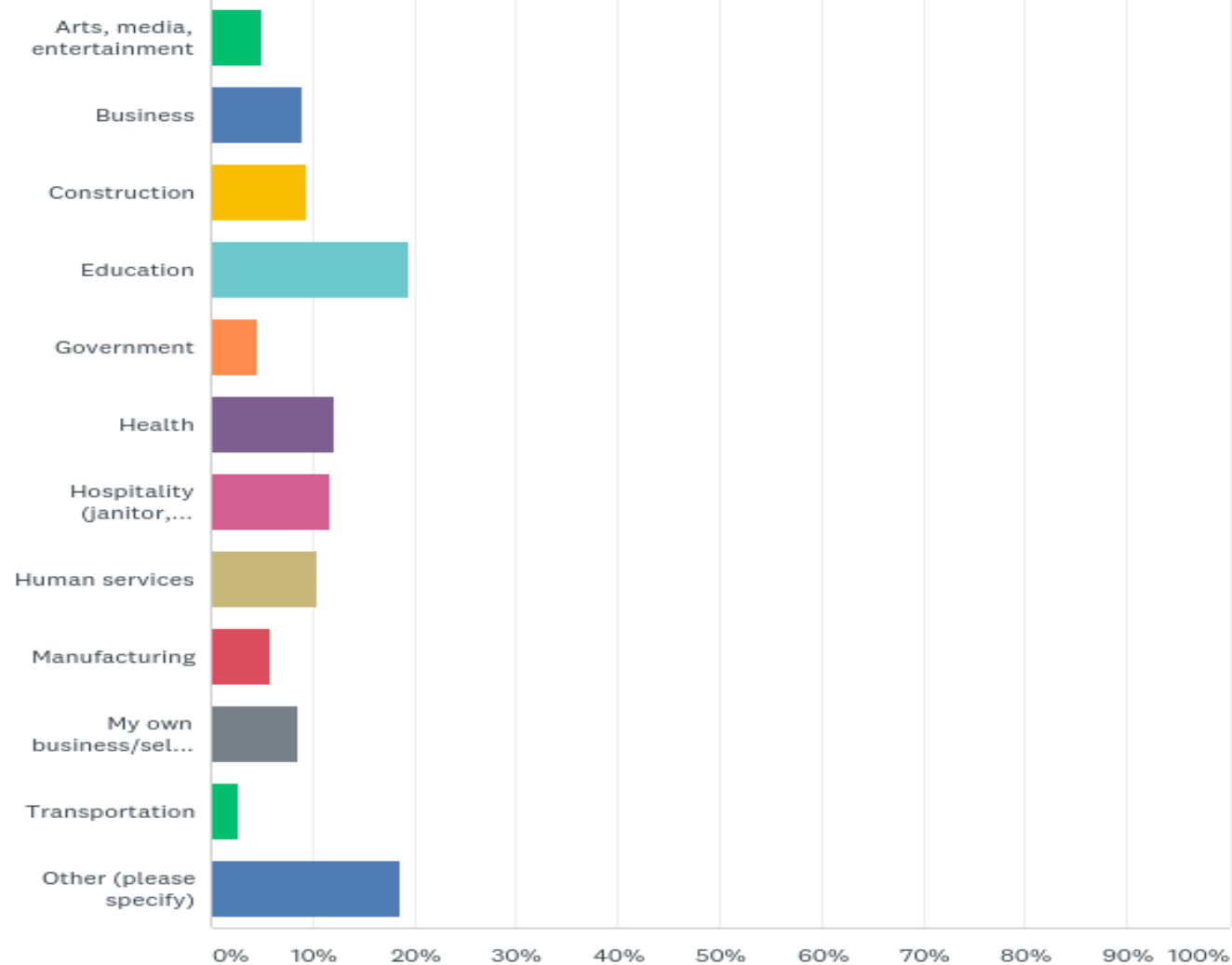

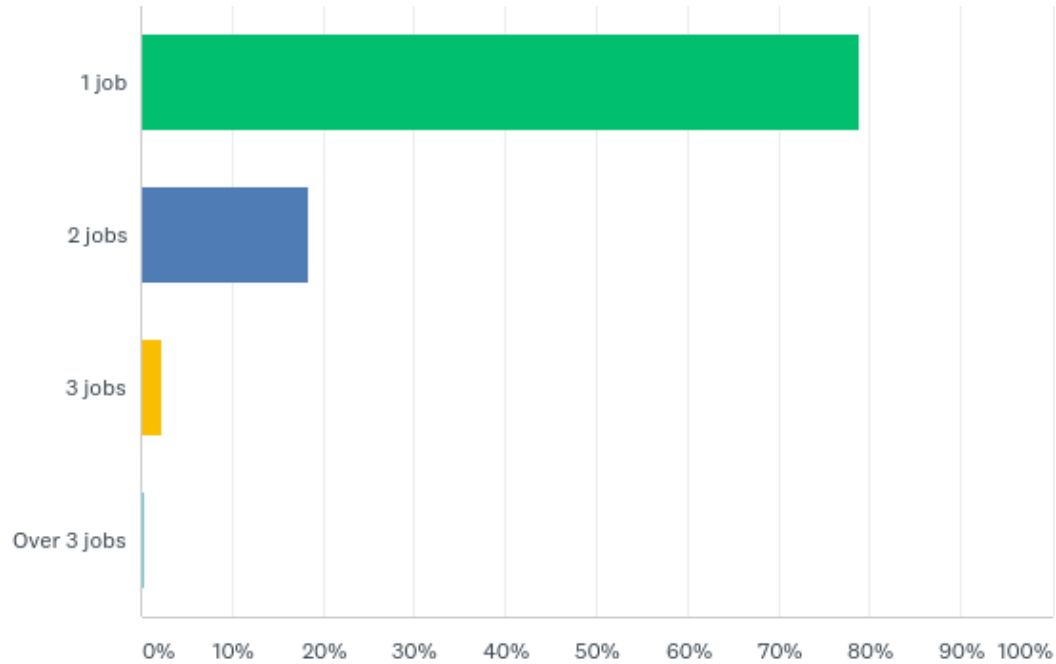

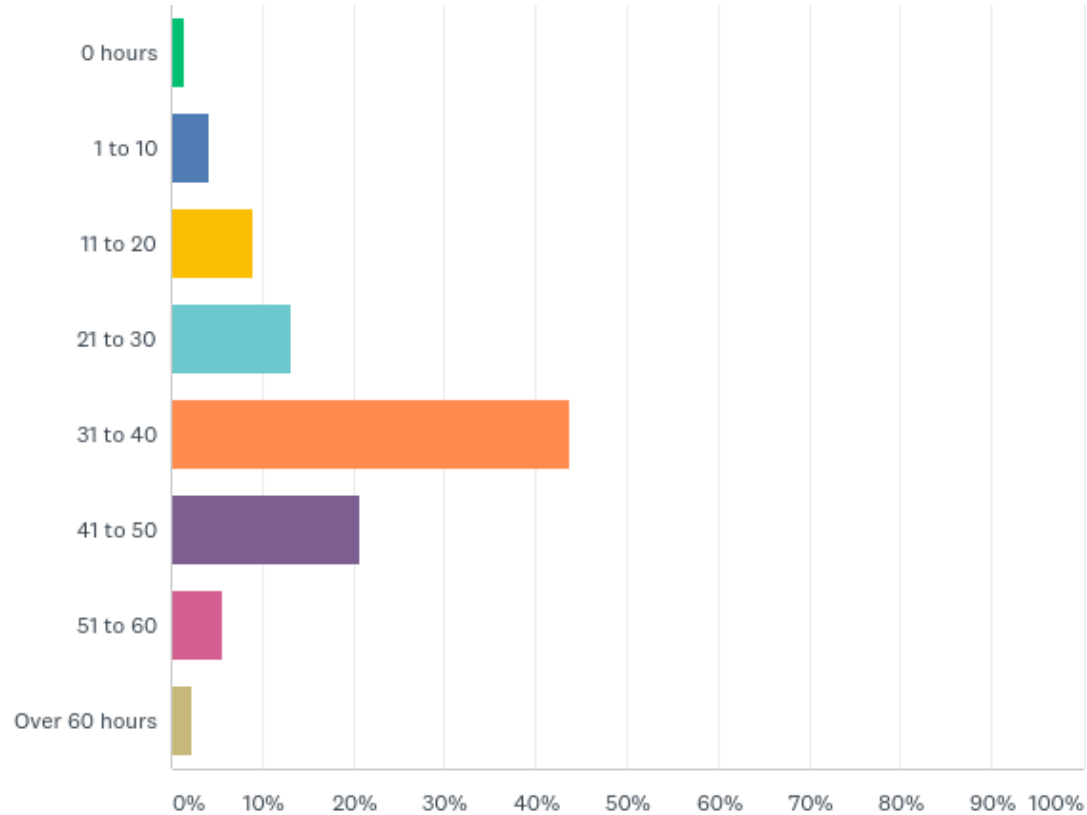

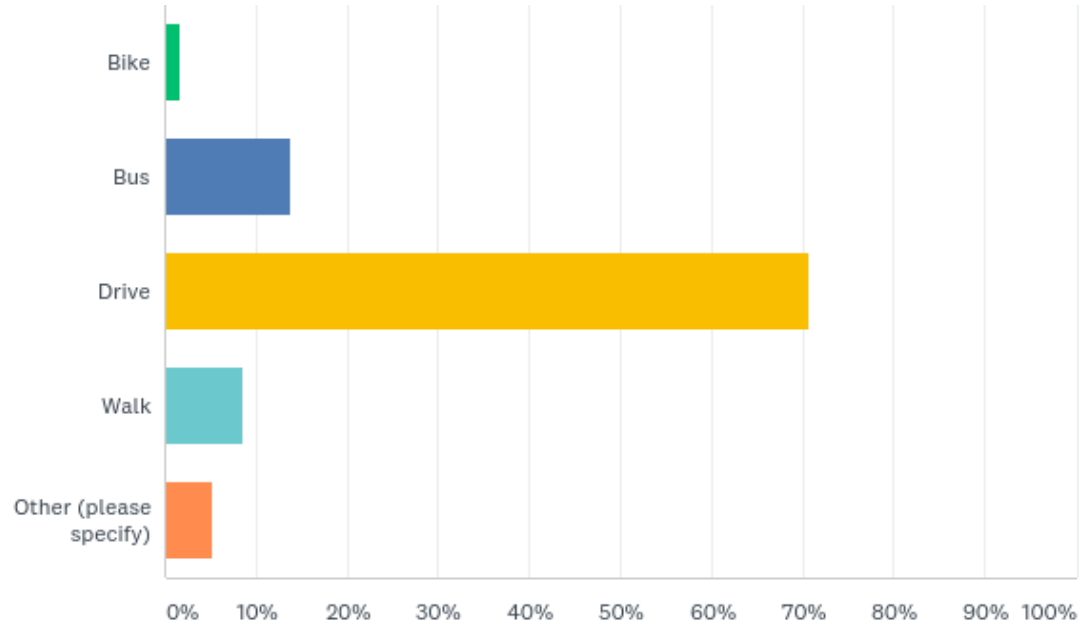

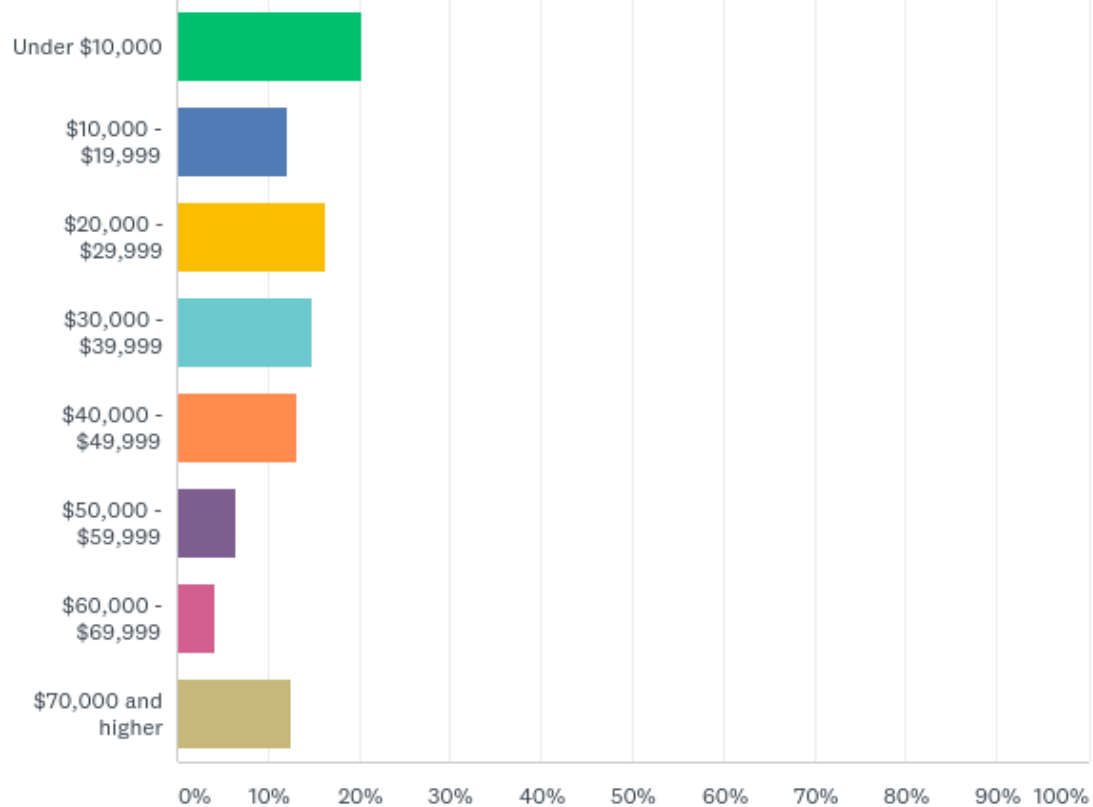

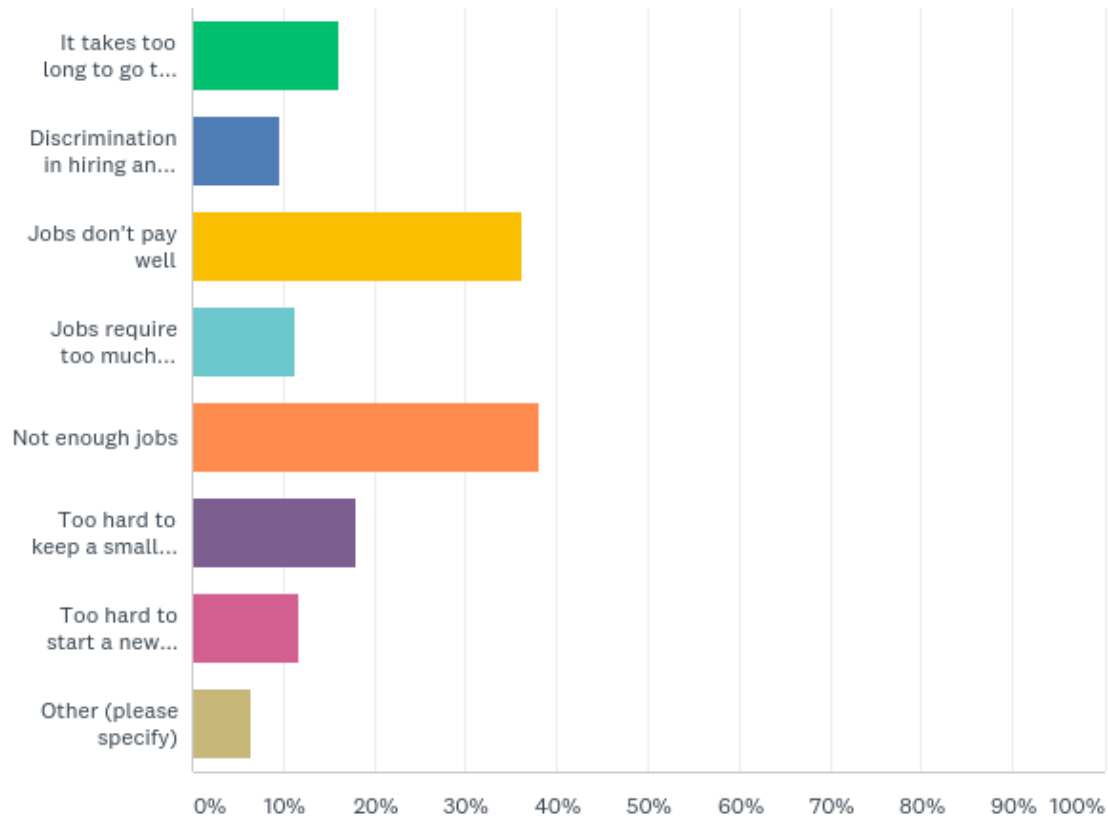

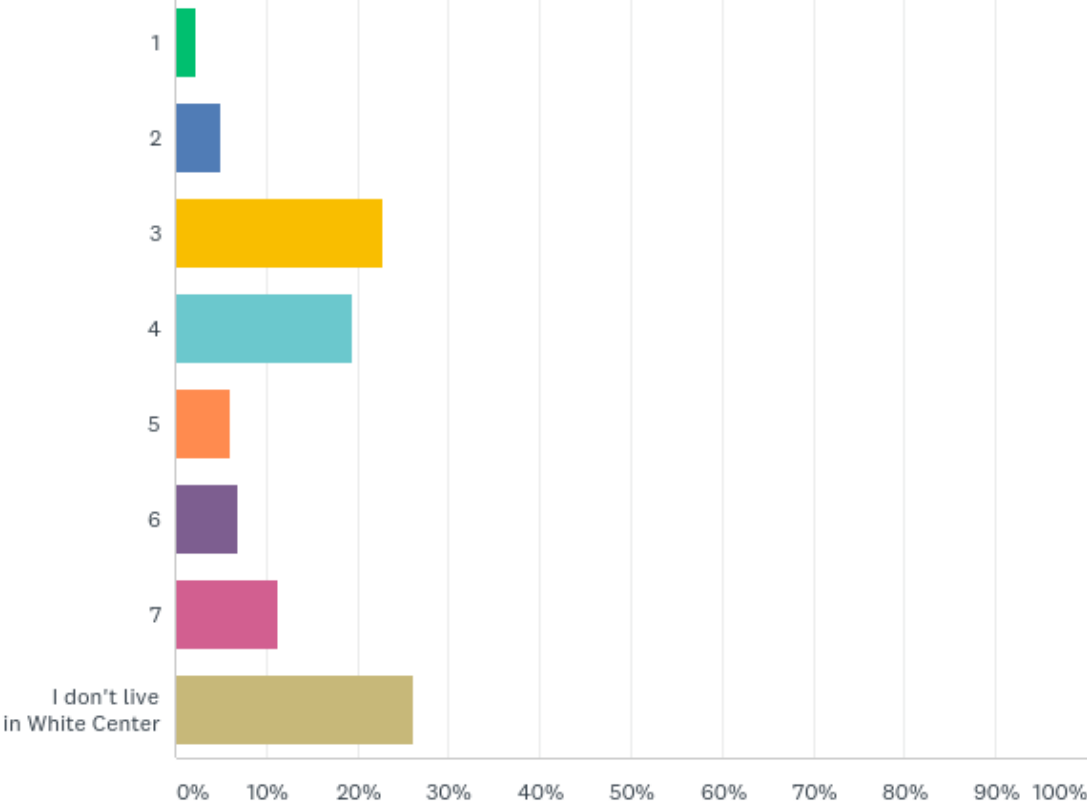

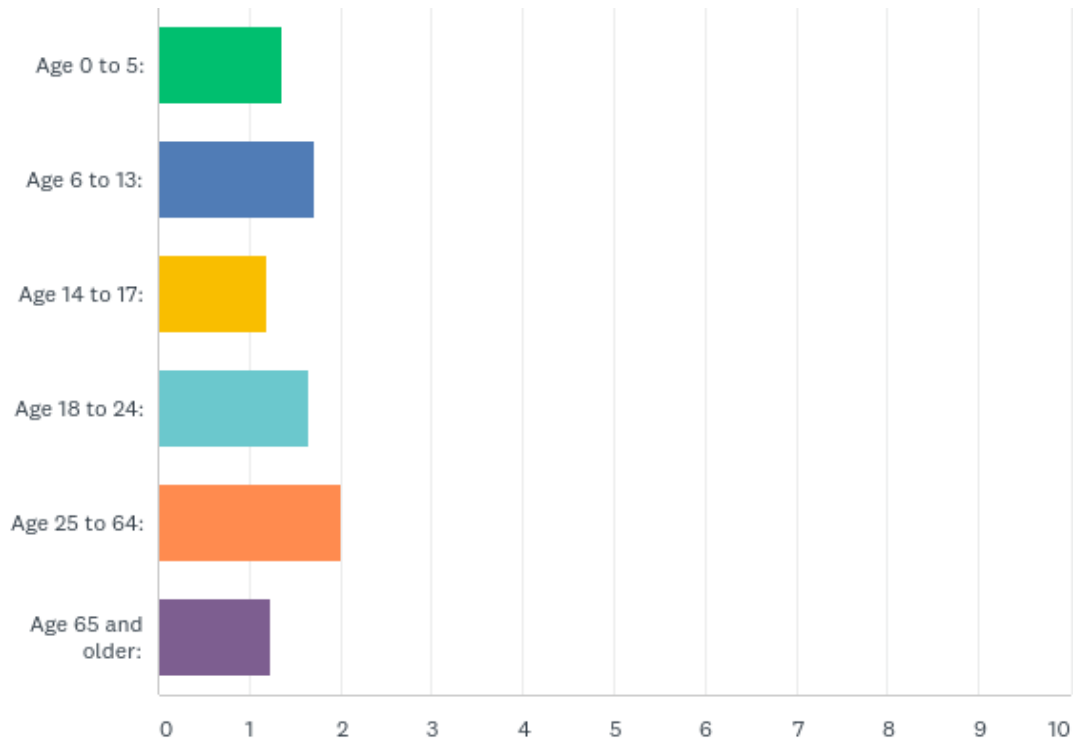

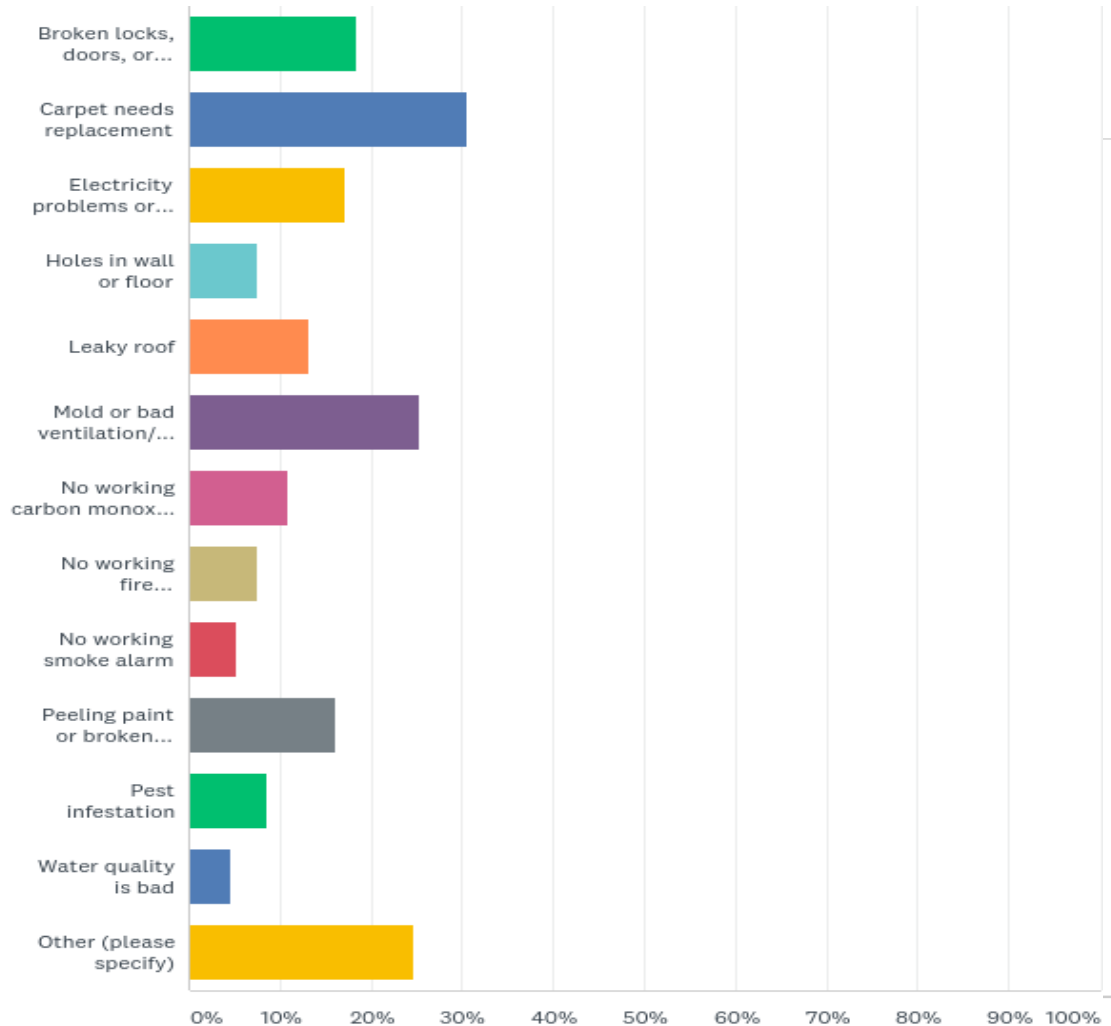

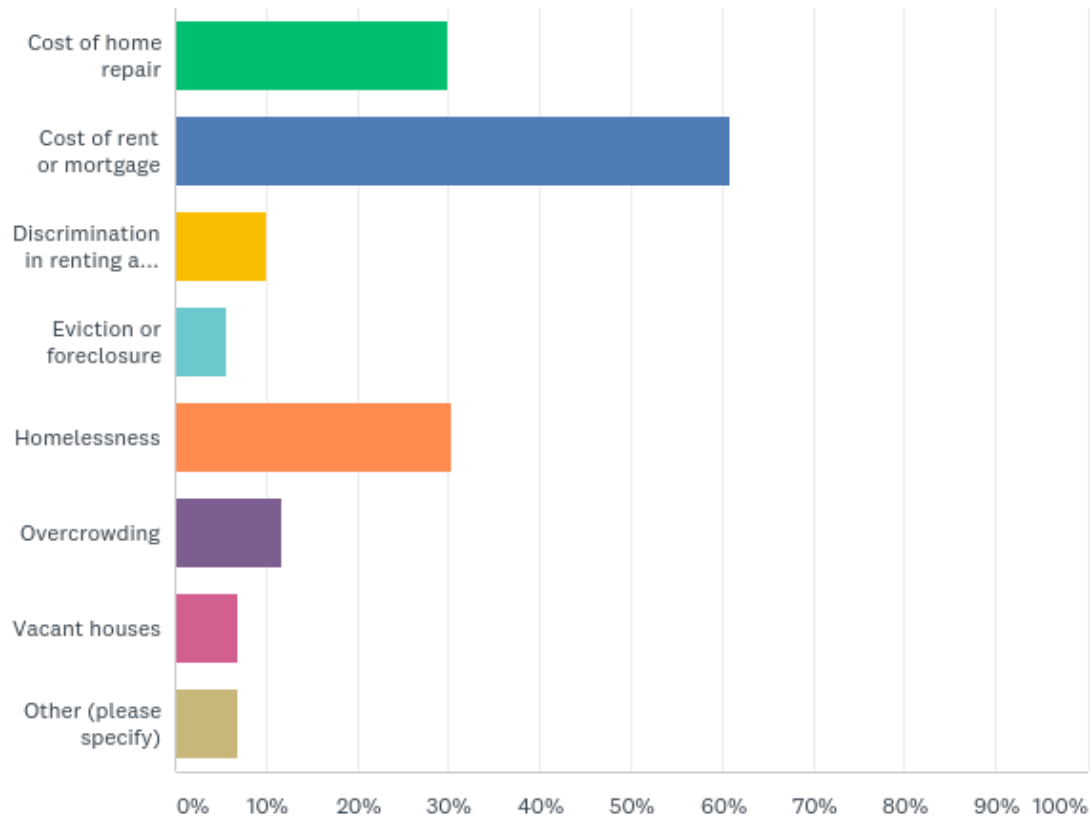

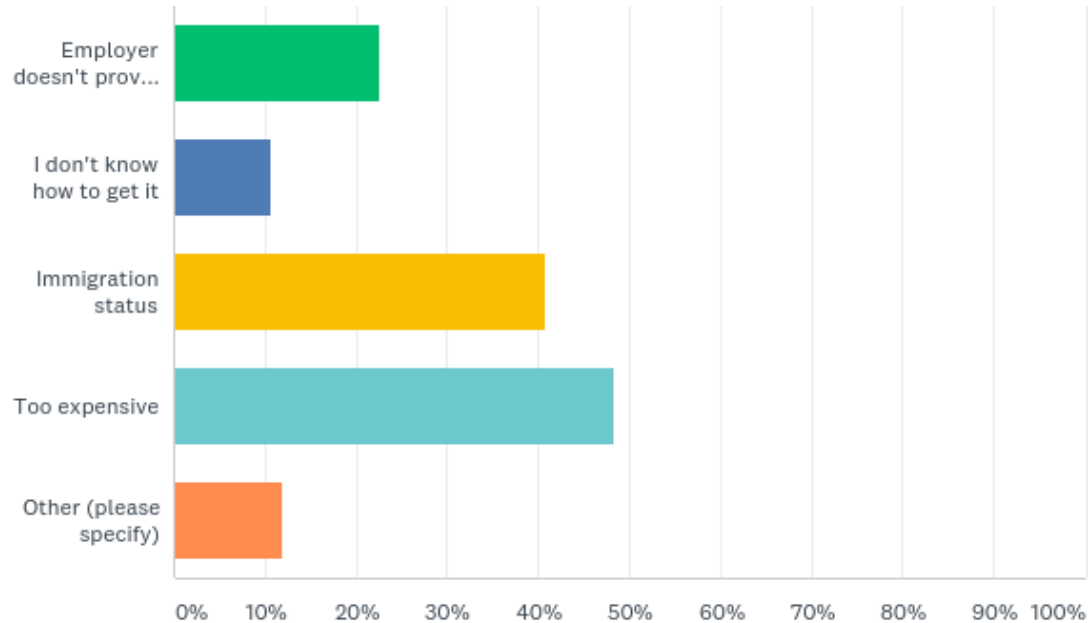

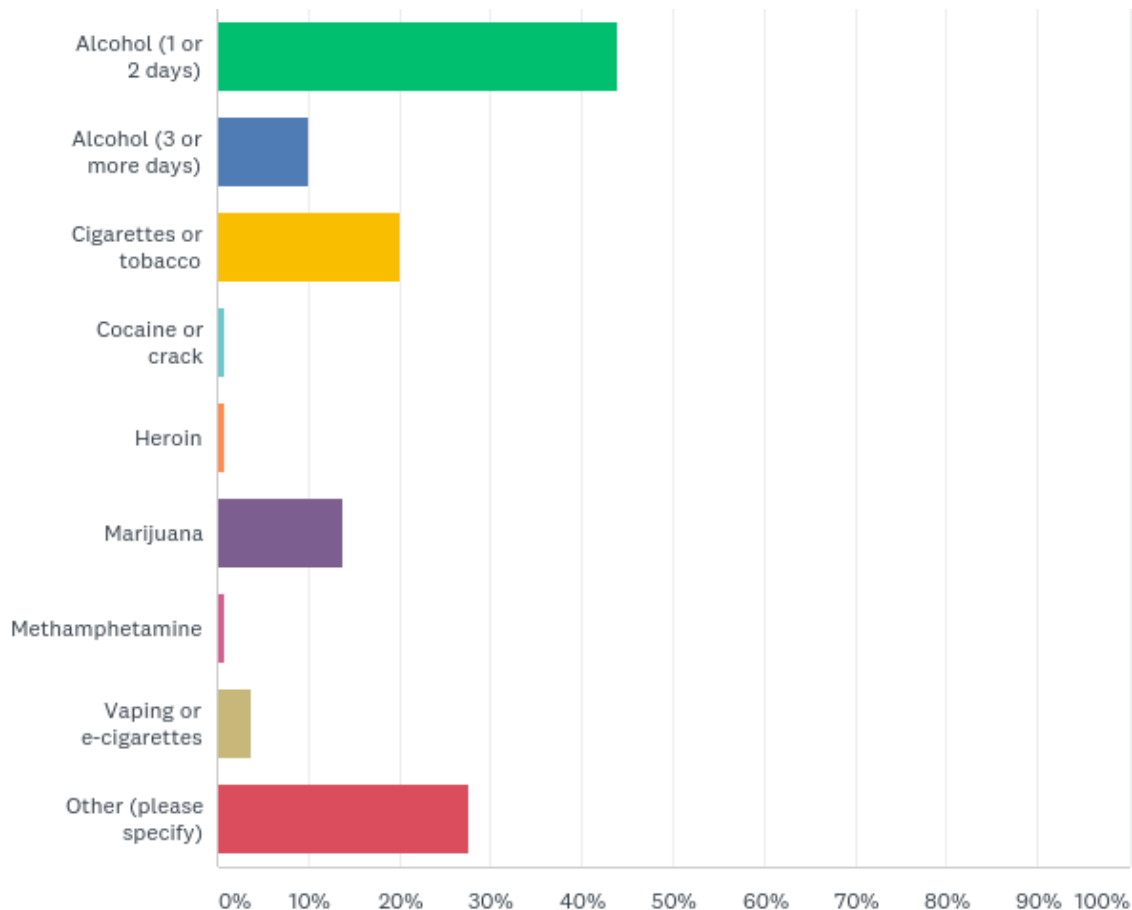

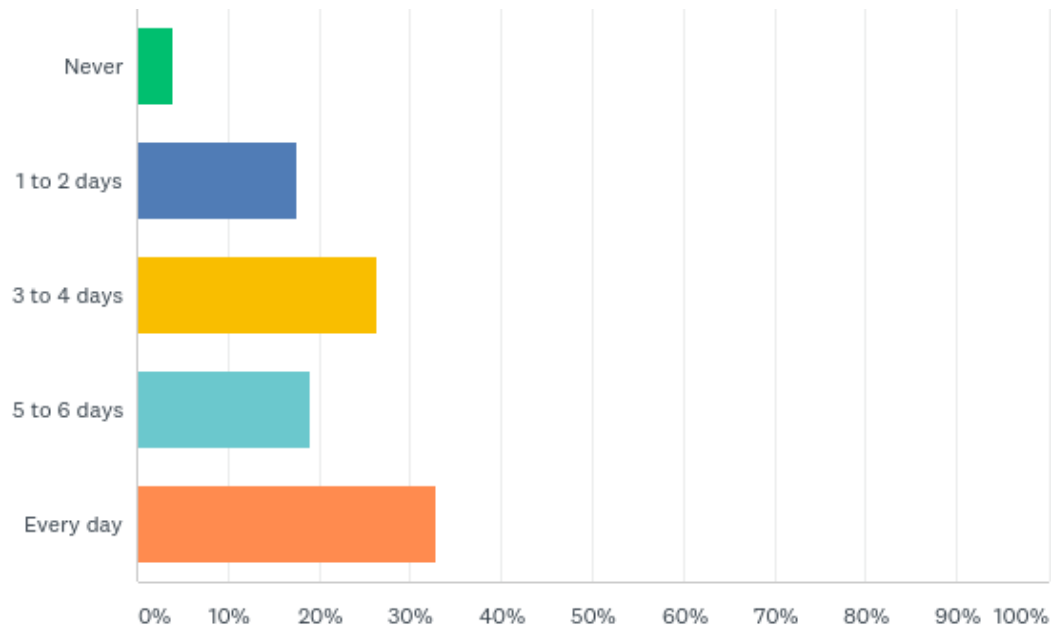

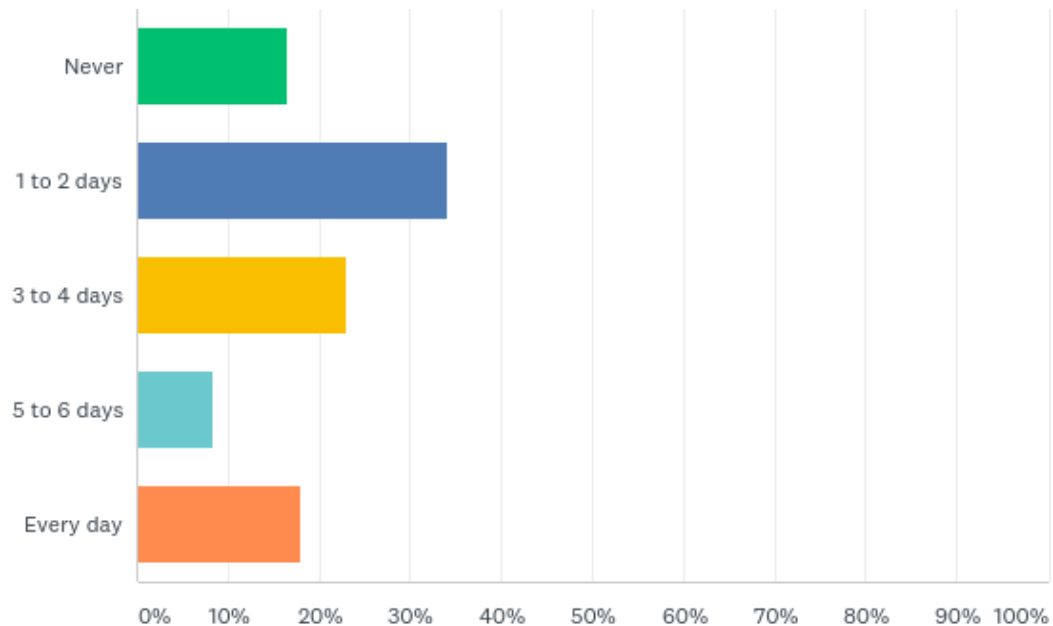

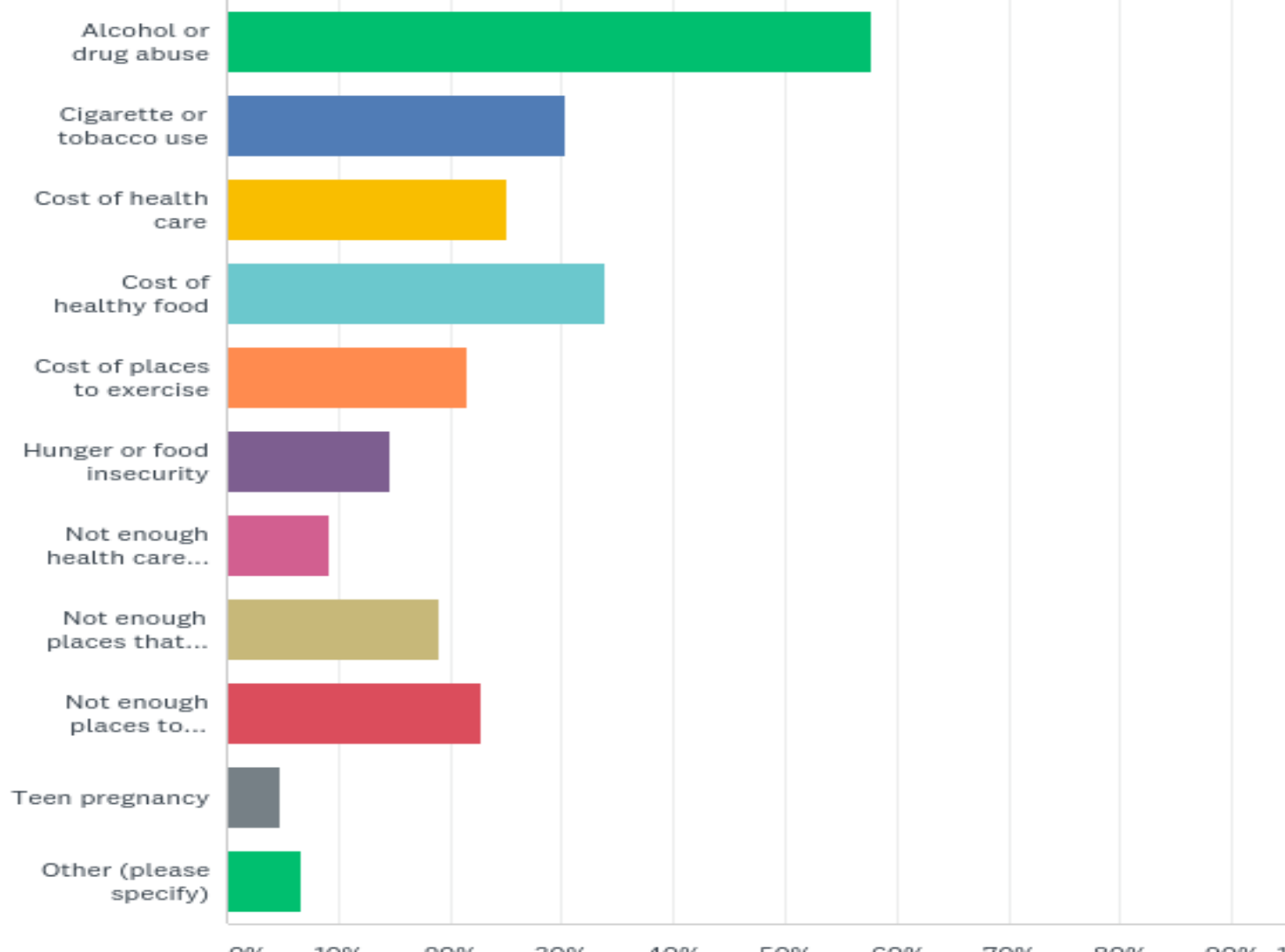

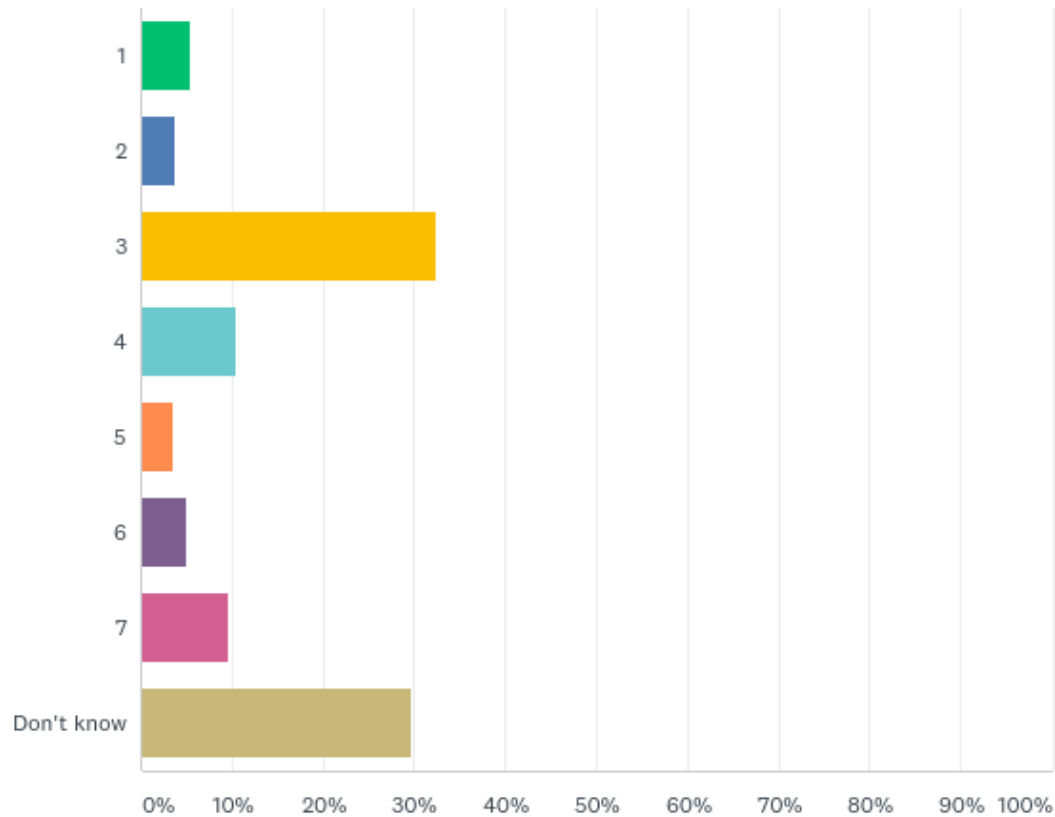

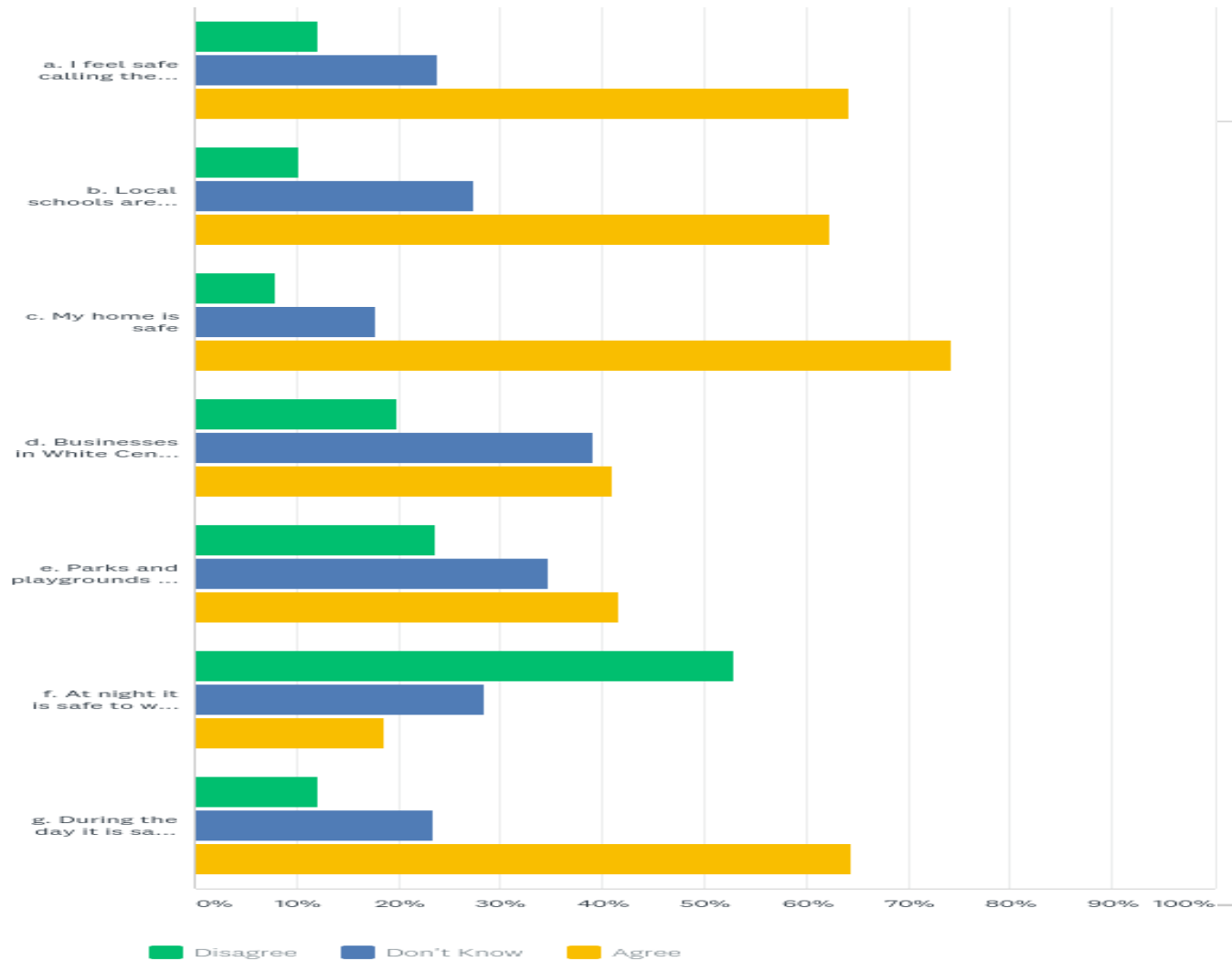

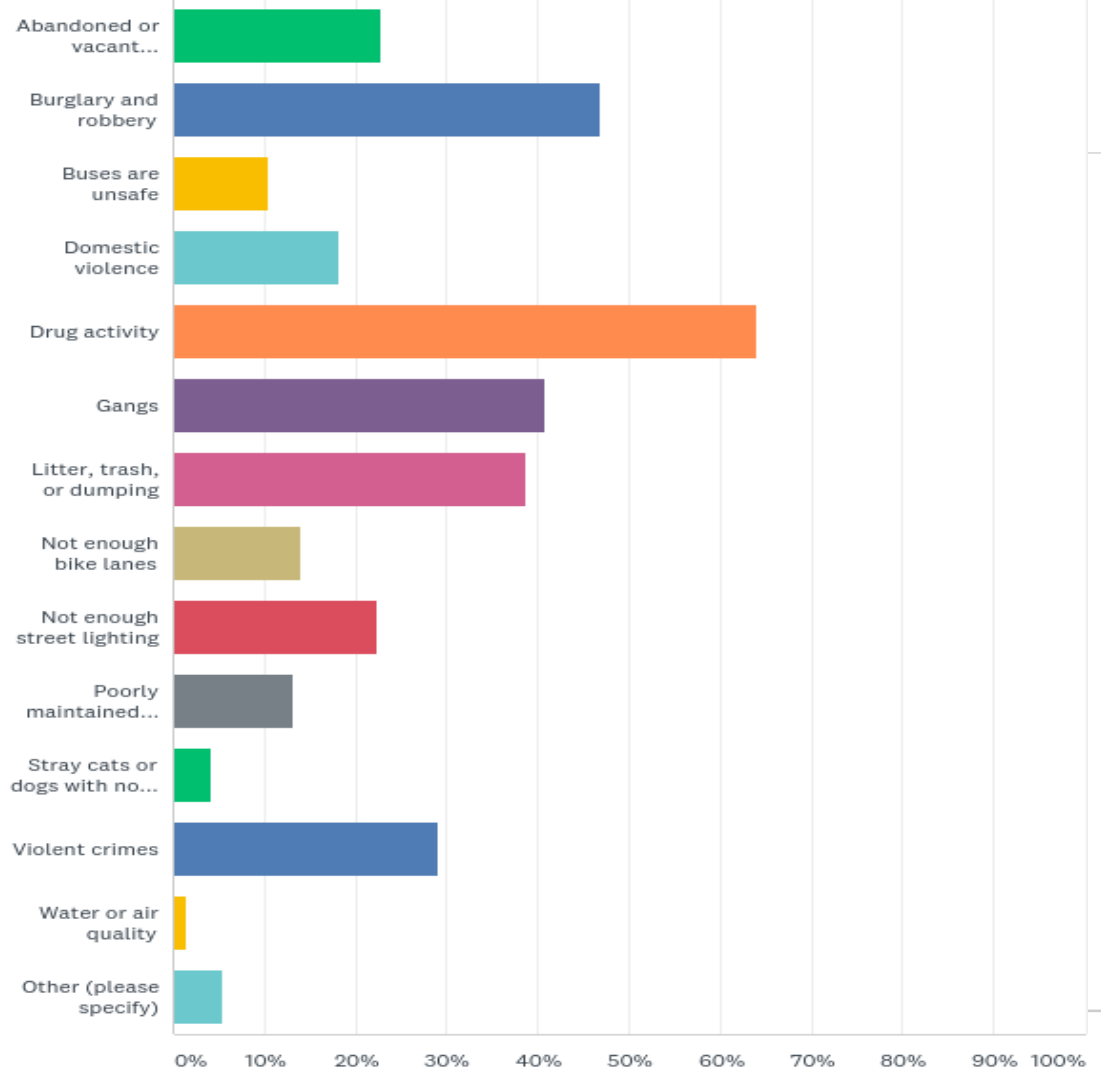

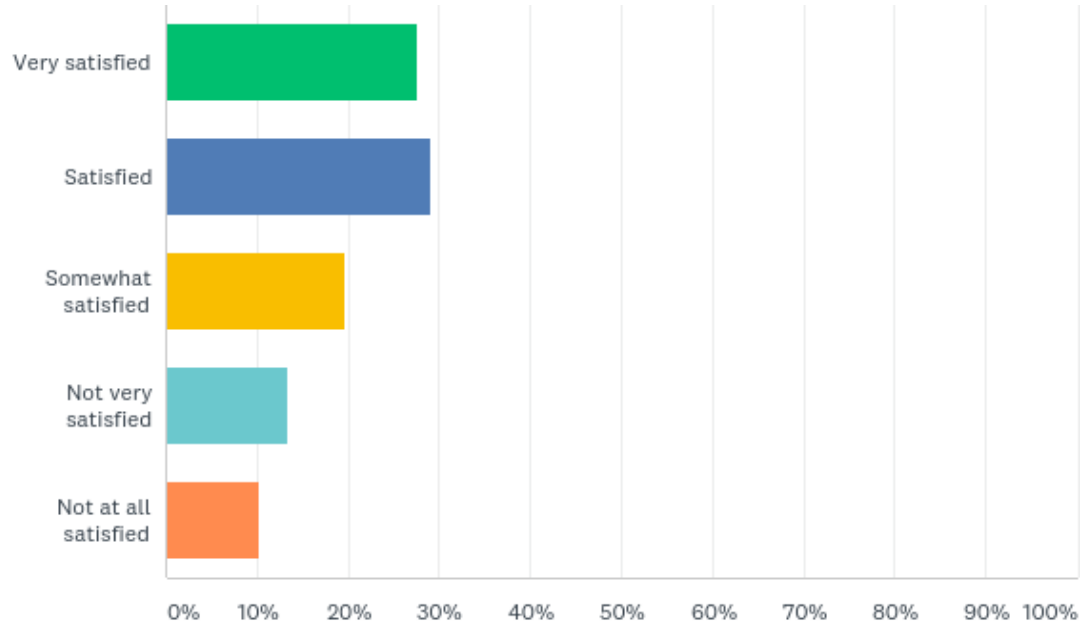

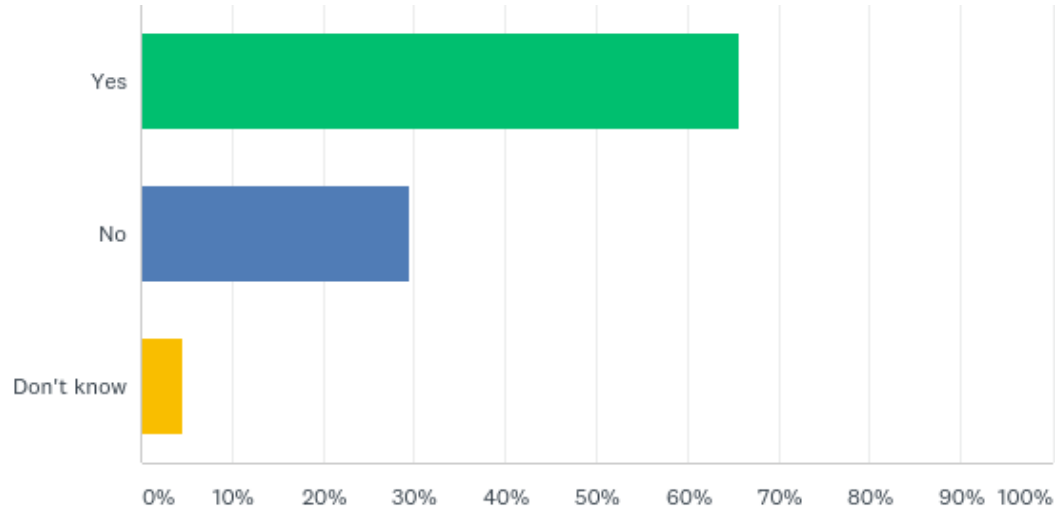

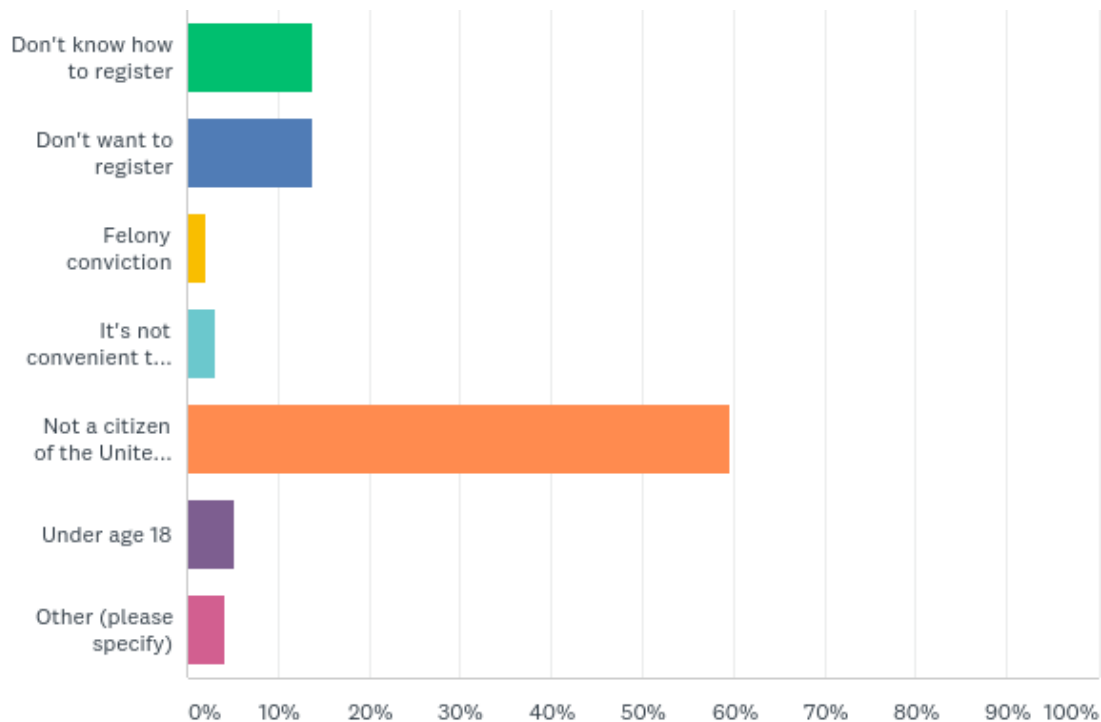

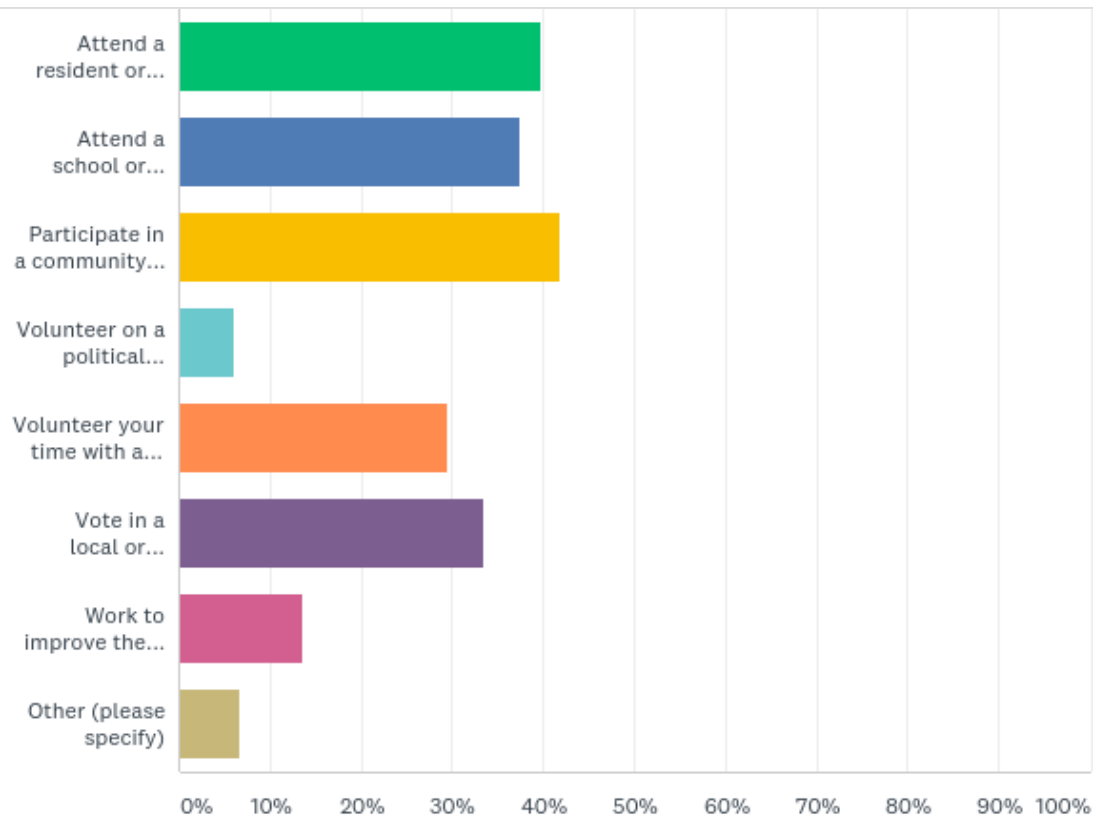

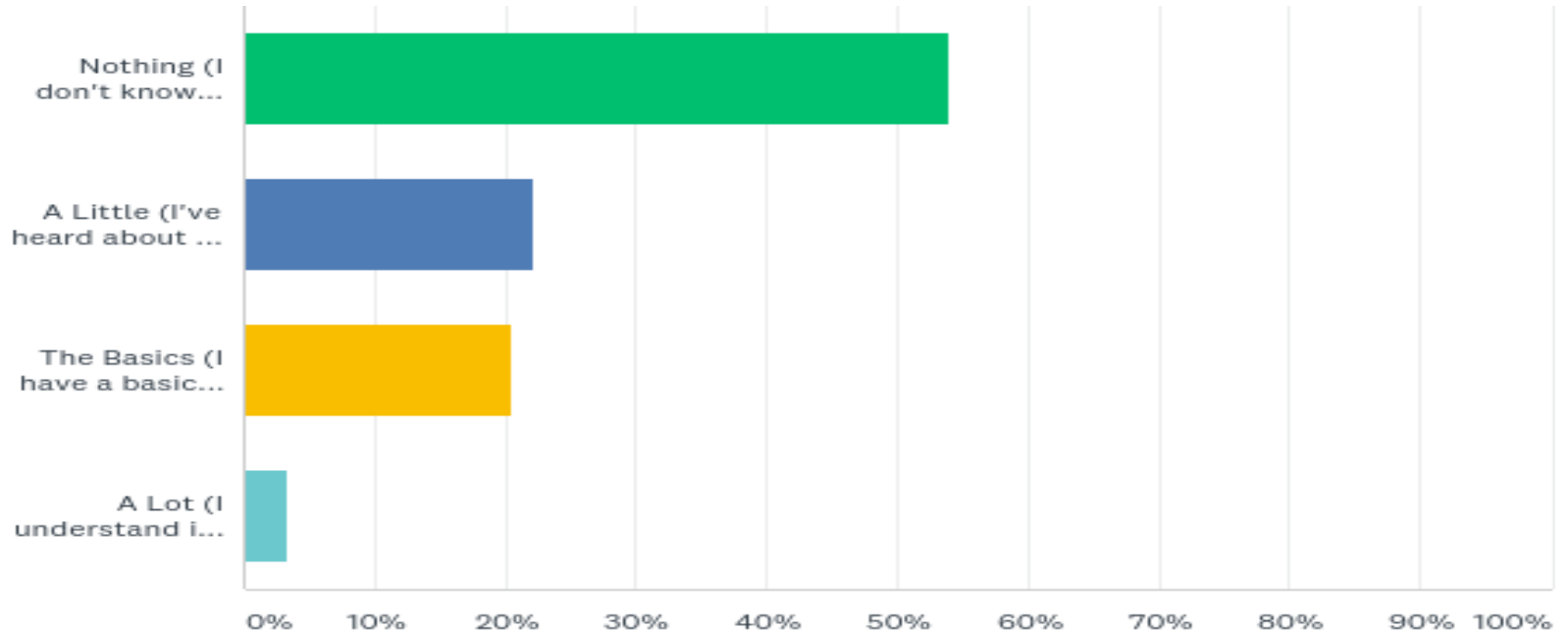

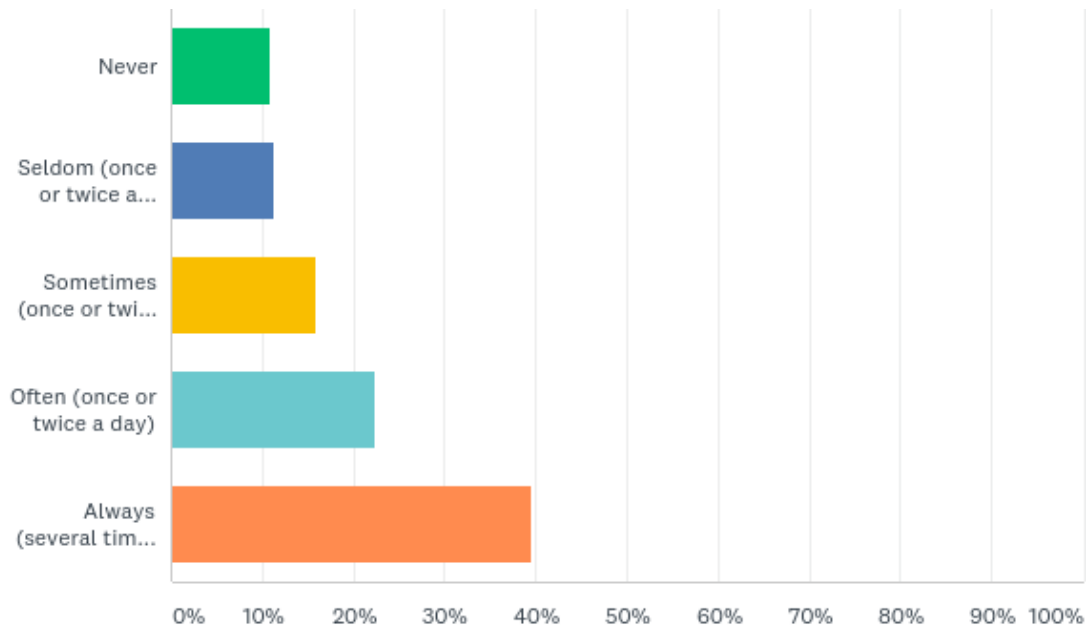

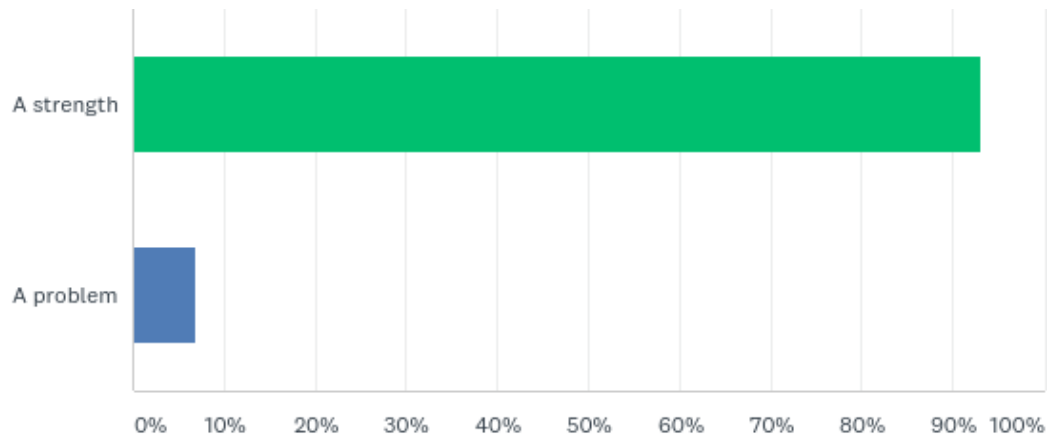

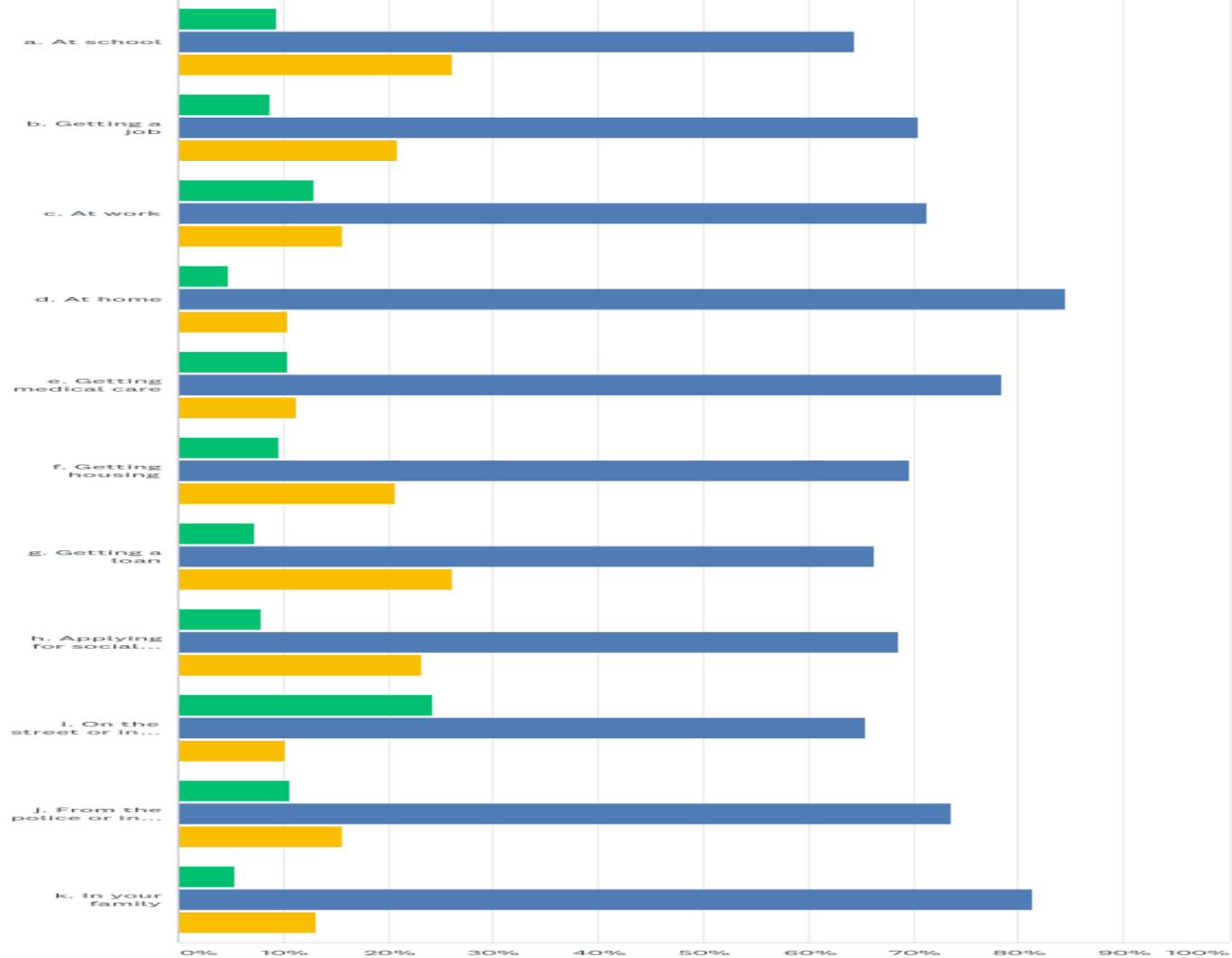

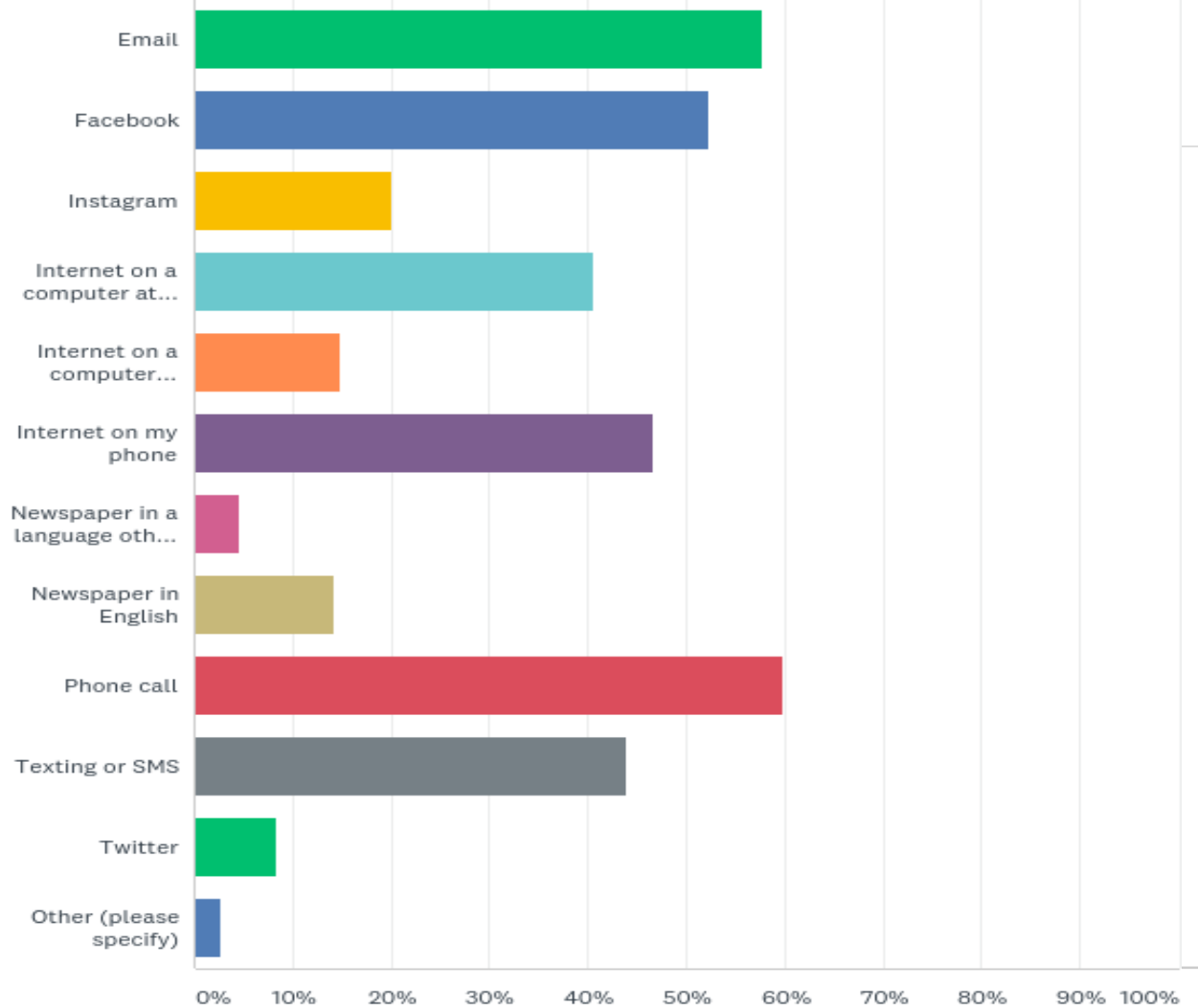

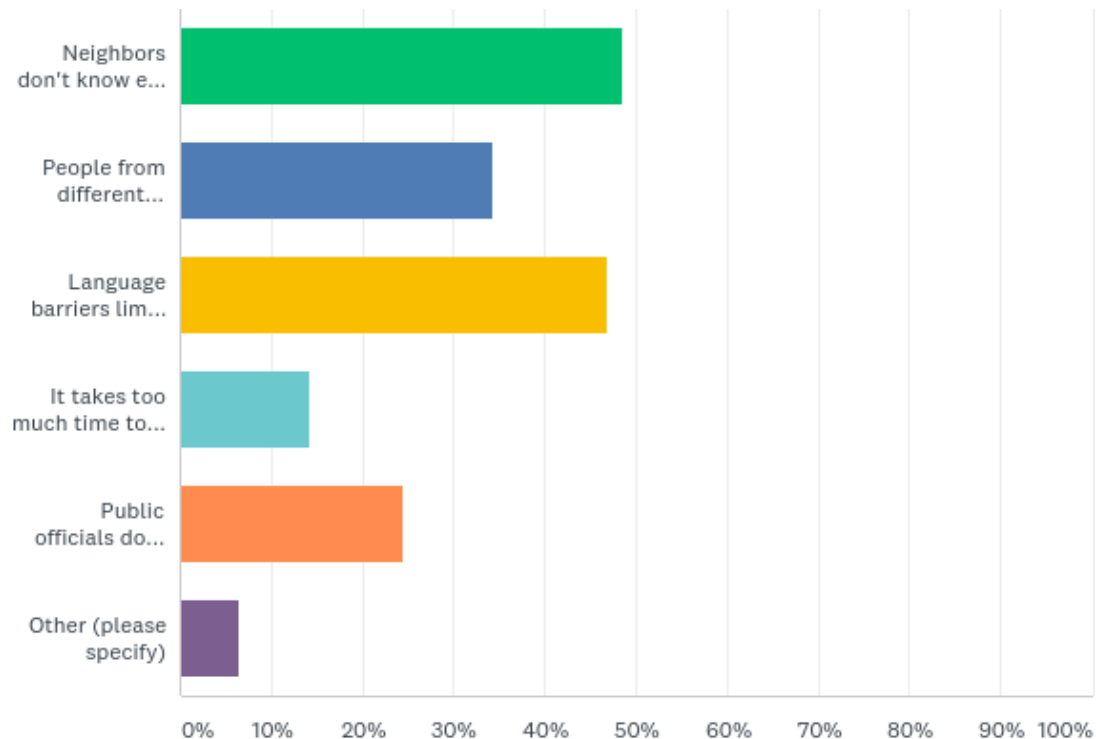

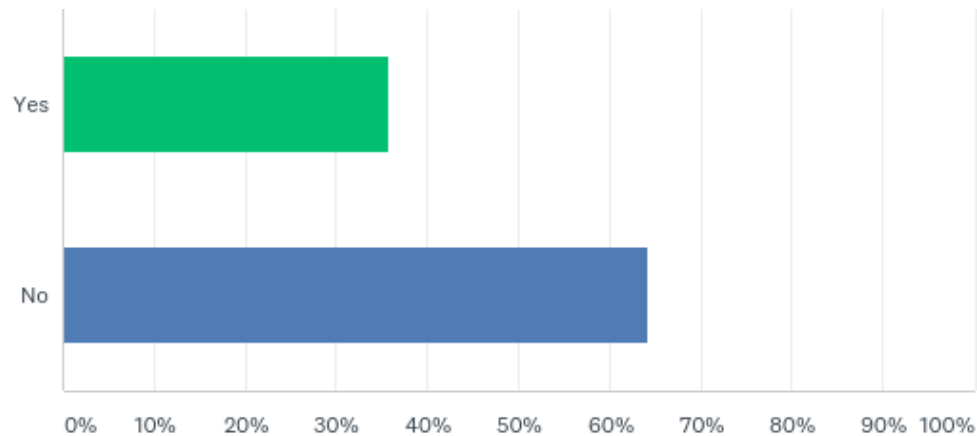

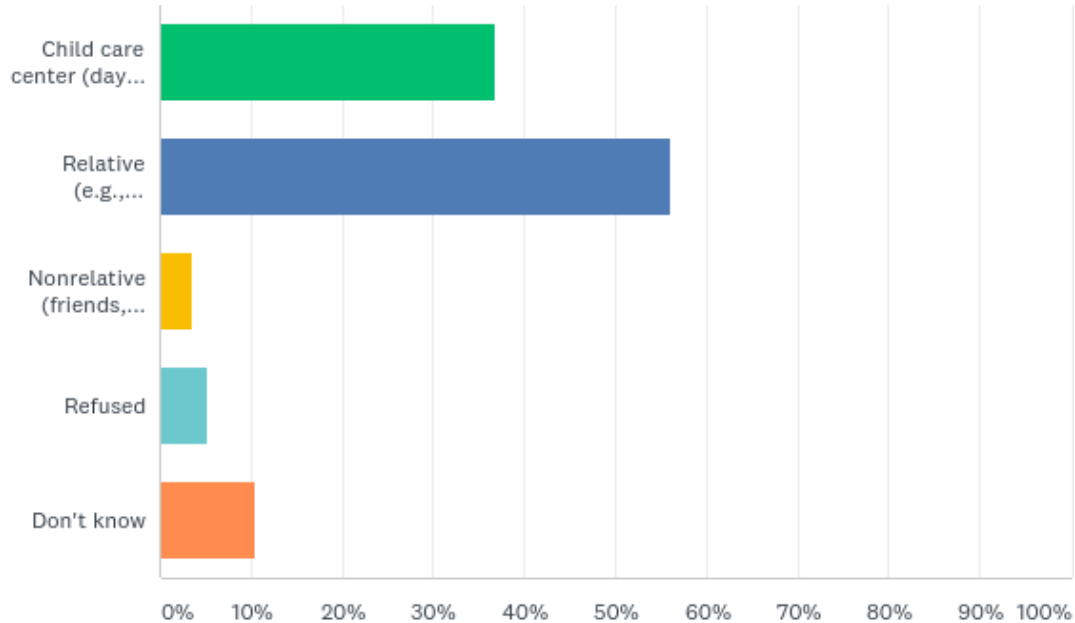

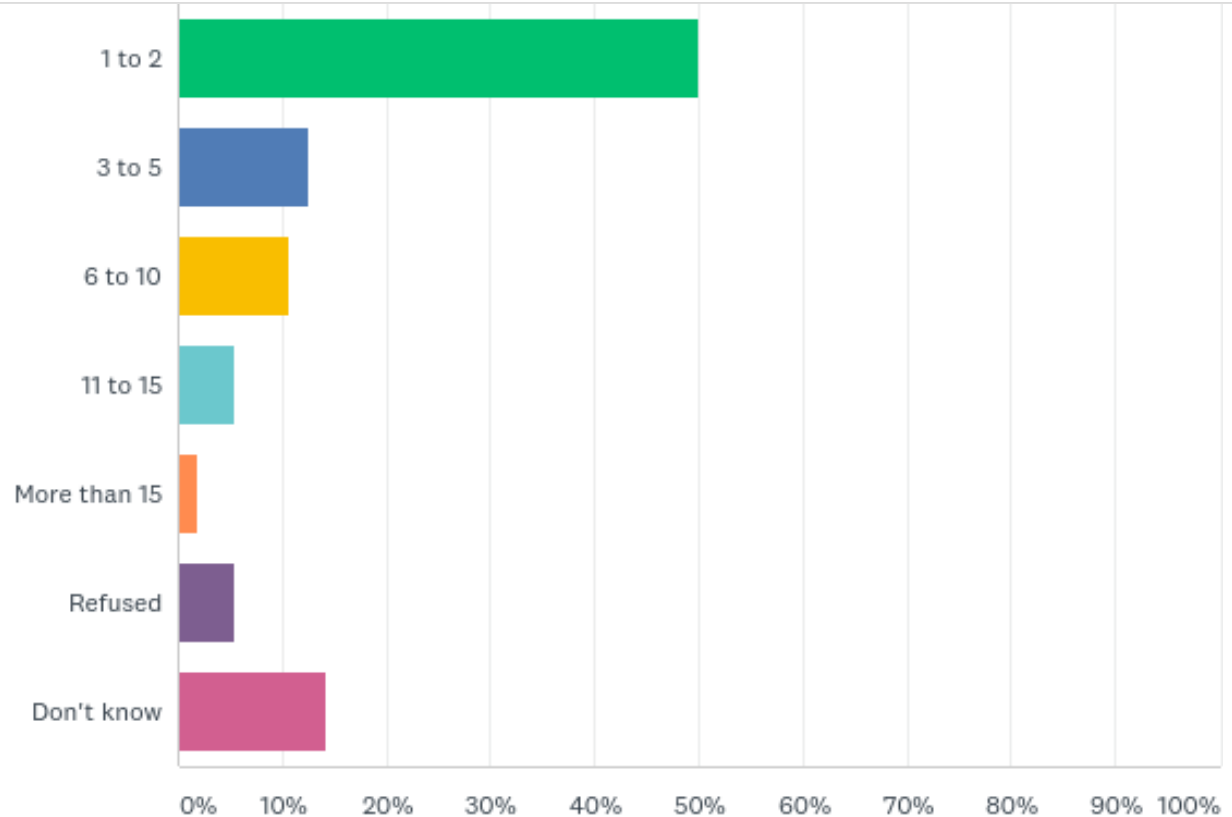

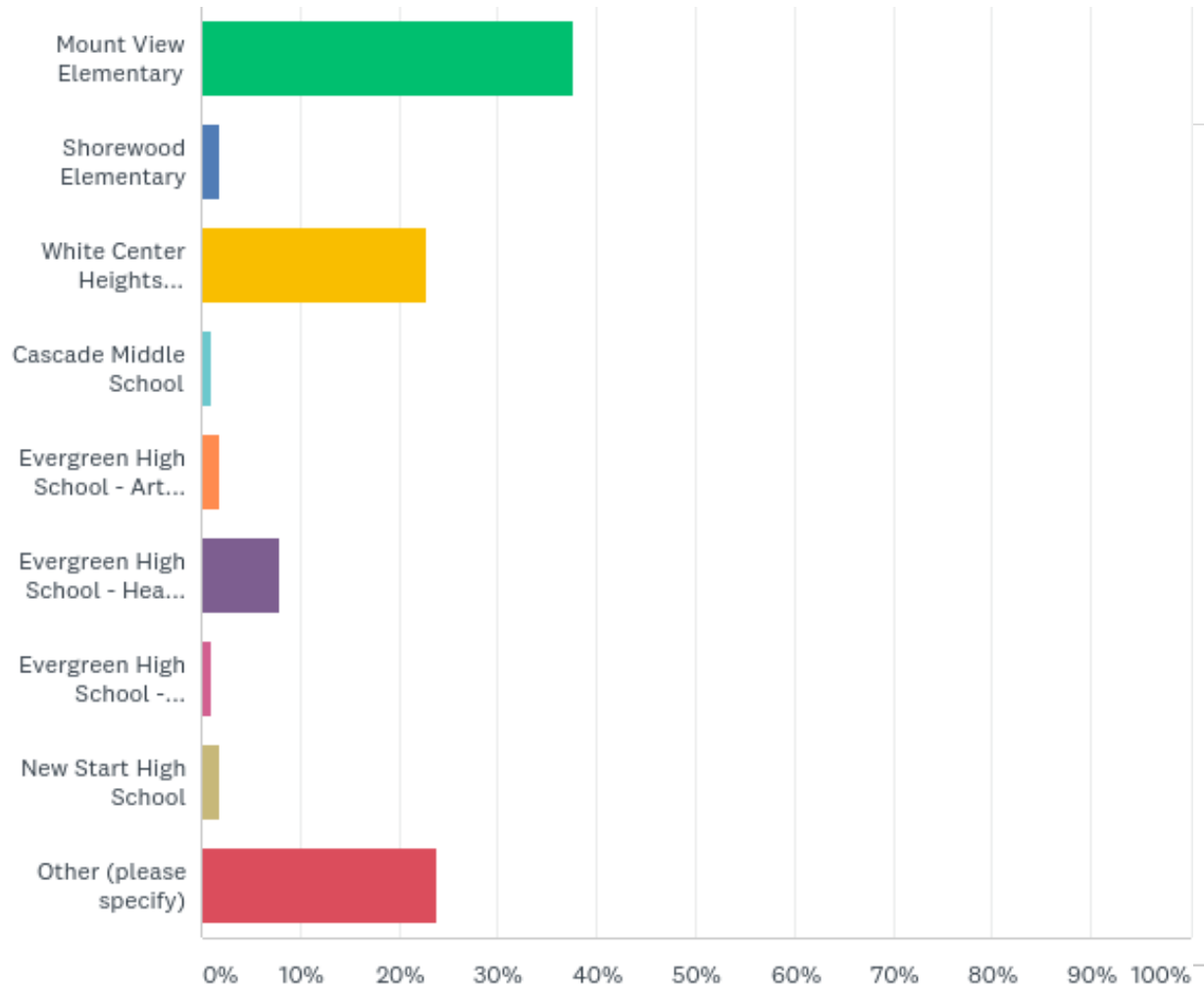

Q66: What school does this child attend? (If they attend more than one school, select the school they attend most of the time)



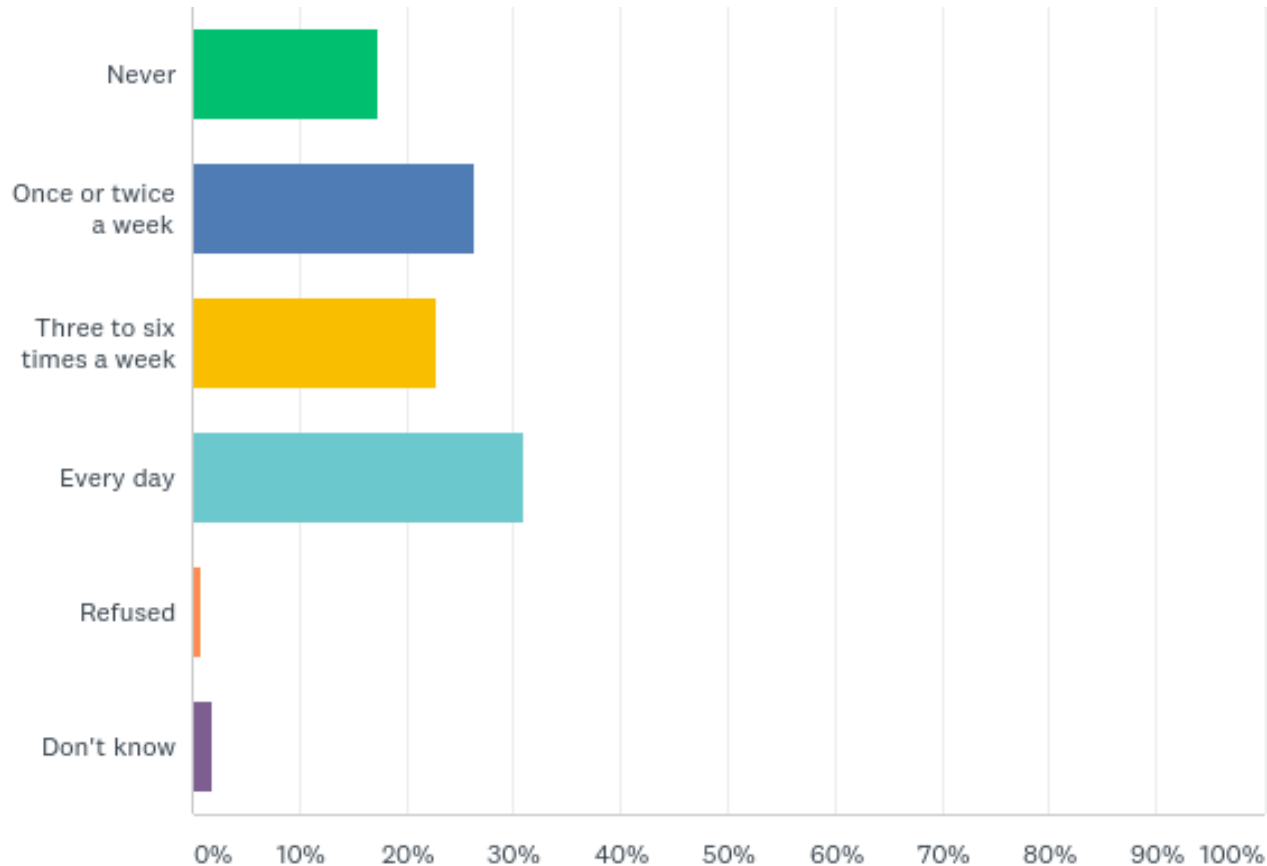

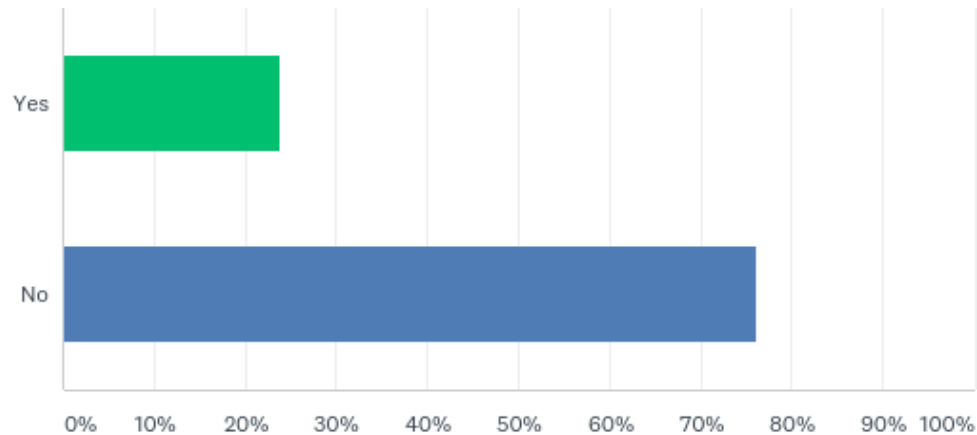

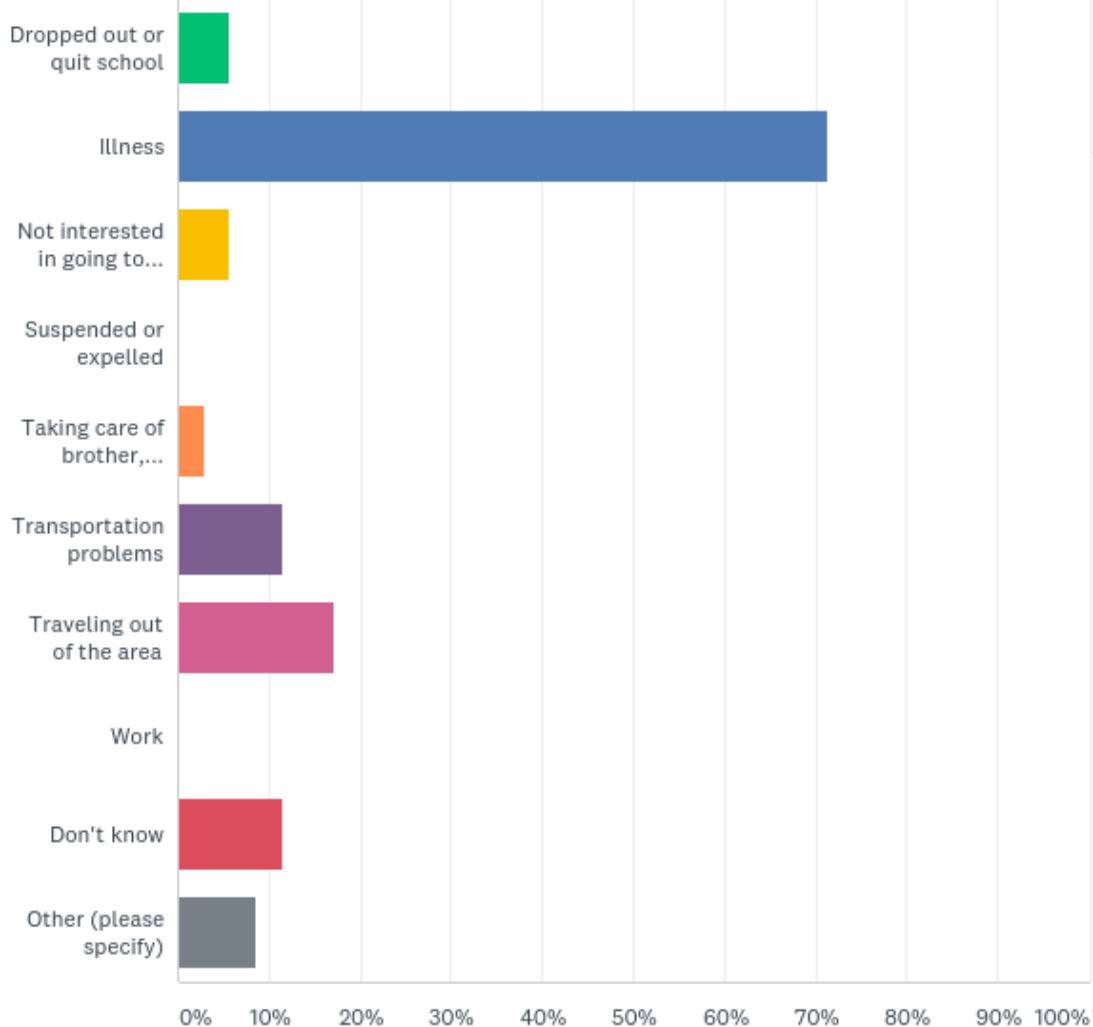

Q70: (If yes) Why has your child missed over a week of school? (Check all that apply)



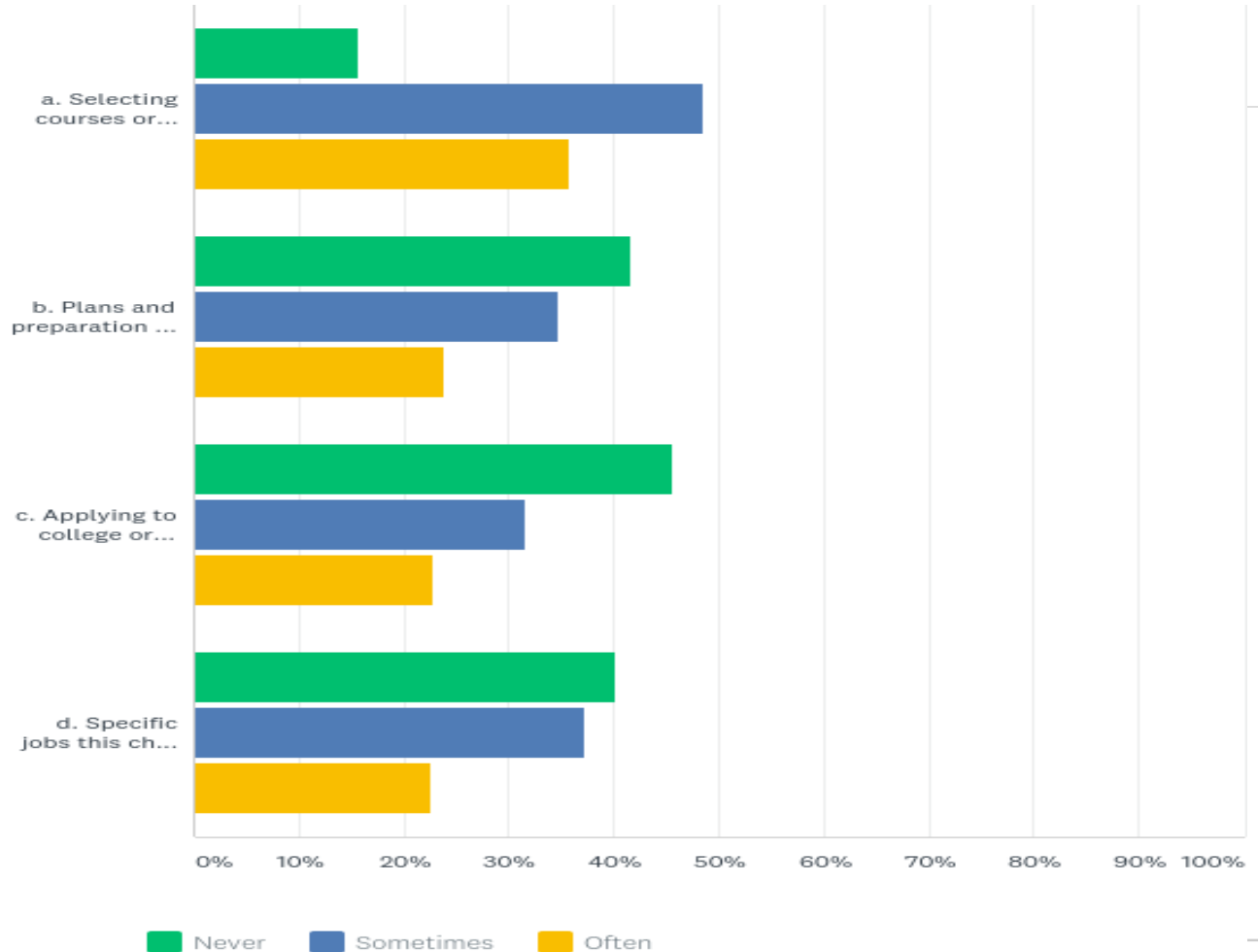

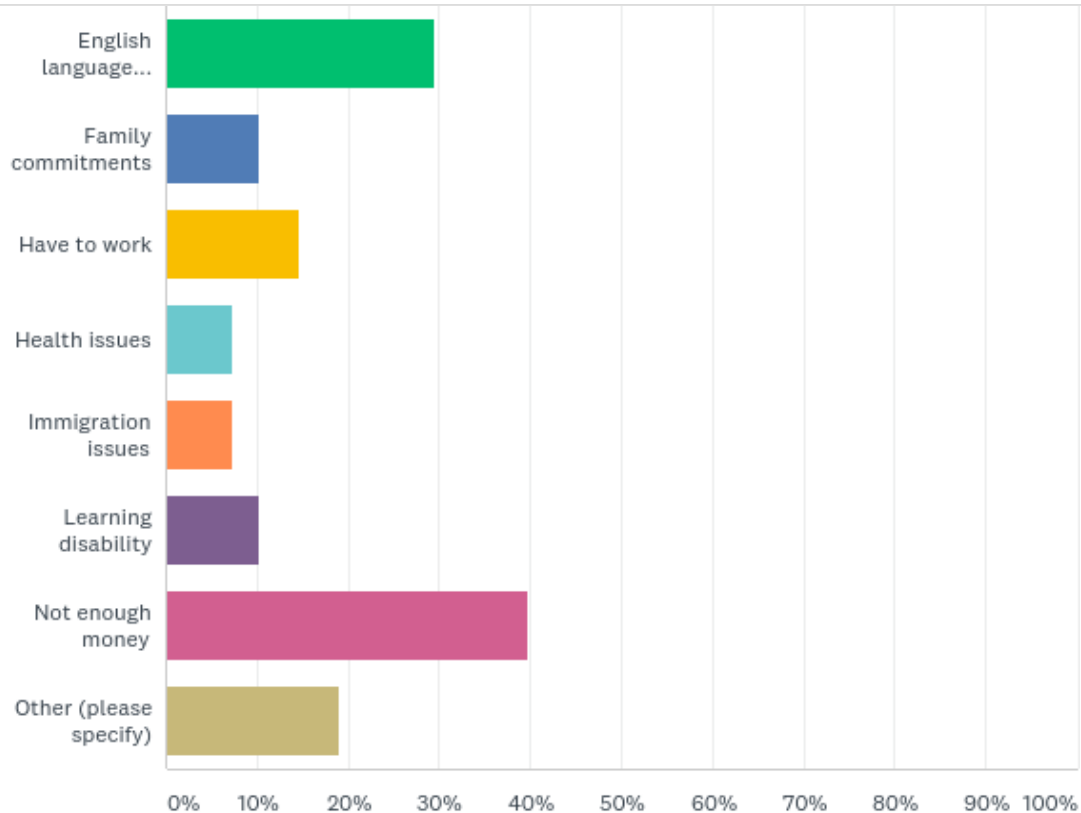

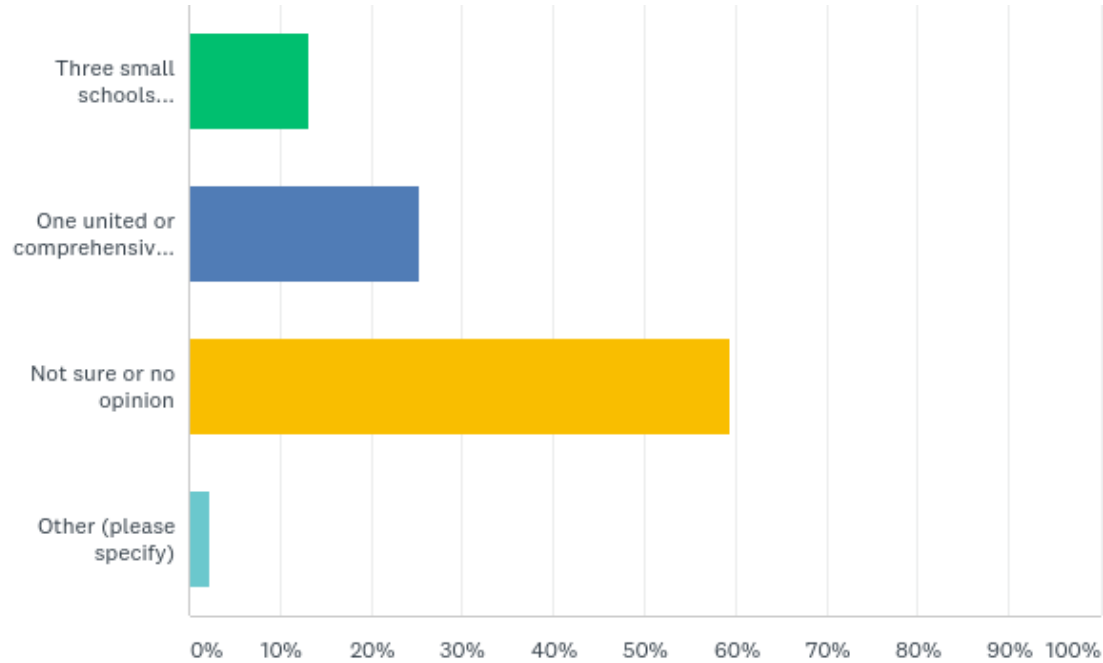

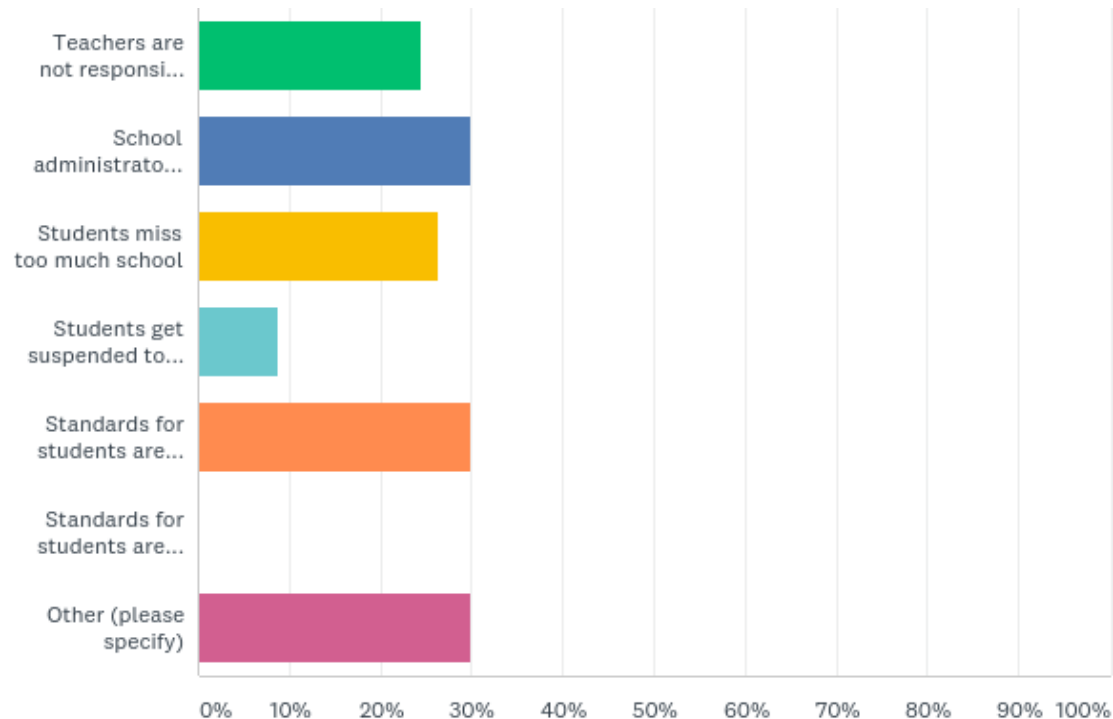

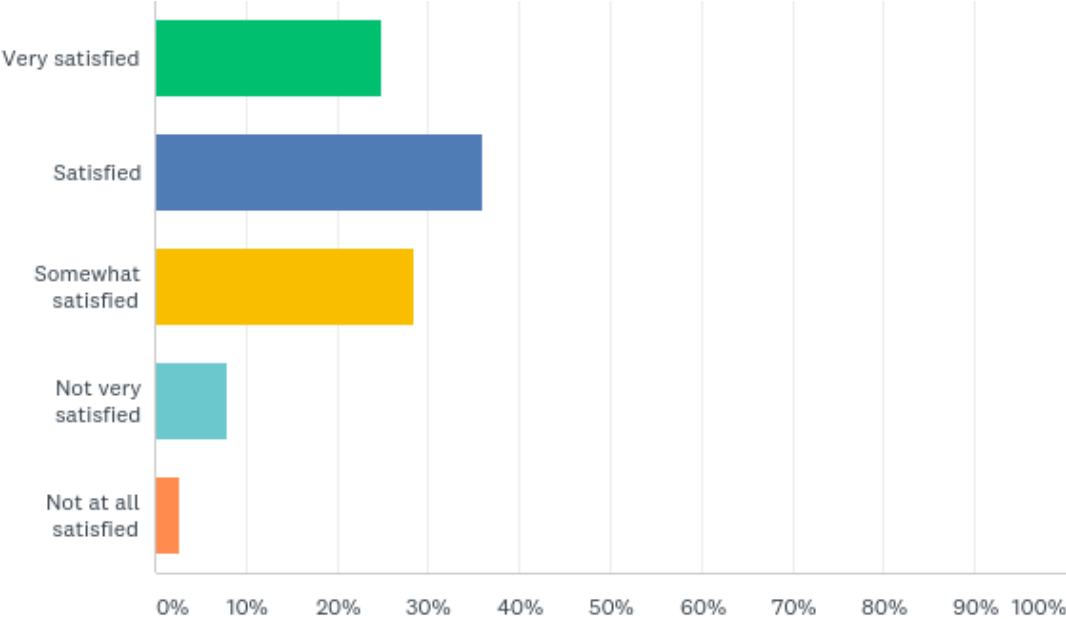

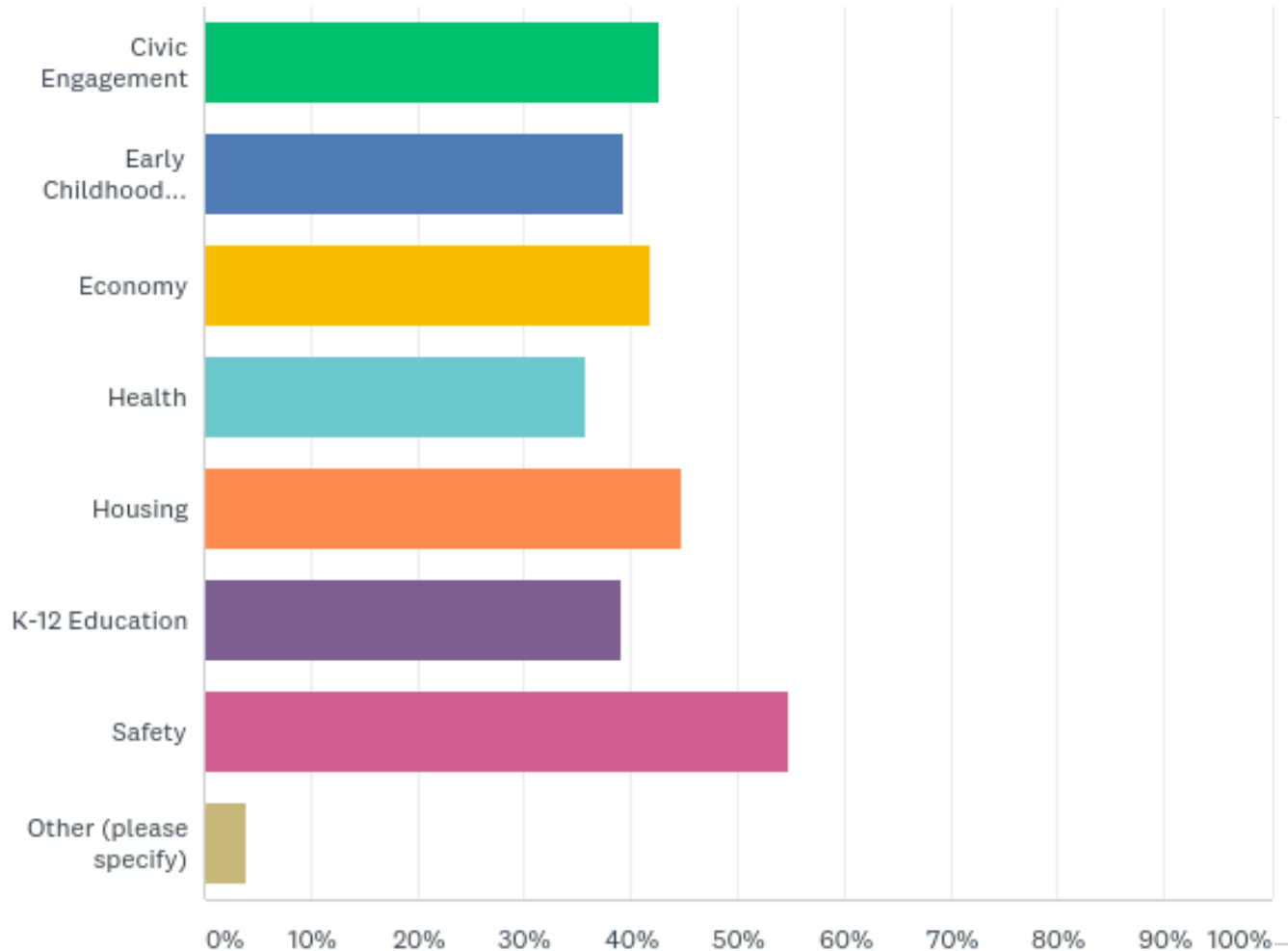
