






Approximately 29.8% of White Center residents are foreign-born. Foreign-born residents come from over 32 countries around the world.





North Highline includes unincorporated White Center, Boulevard Park communities, and several other neighborhoods in the area.







OLDER WITH EMPLOYMENT (2010-2016)


